JOB SUMMARY

Under the general guidance and direction of the Chef, maintain and clean inventory of small wares, utensils and kitchen supplies. Cleaning of all food and beverage cooking and prep areas including main kitchen, floors and back hallways.

MAJOR DUTIES

(Any one position may not include all of the duties listed, nor do the listed examples include all duties which may be found in positions of this class.) Responsible for cleanliness and storage of food service equipment. Training of new dish washers on cleaning and property standards. Wash dishes, dishware, pots, pans, trays, utensils and other kitchen and food service equipment. Responsible for entire daily cleaning of kitchen including floors, walls and standing equipment. Responsible for return of all dishware and equipment to designated areas each shift.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

High school diploma or GED equivalent, and previous experience preferred.

Ability to handle high heat and moisture, meet minimum age requirements, ability to follow directions and communicate effectively with supervisor and coworkers. Ability to lift heavy loads on a constant basis. Ability to accomplish all tasks as assigned.

SPECIAL QUALIFICATIONS

Must have Food & Beverage Service Worker permit Must be willing to work flexible hours and schedules to include evenings, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays and irregular hours as dictated by event schedule.
