### 1 **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE & SALE OF NOT MORE THAN \$2,500,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT** OF SALES TAX REVENUE REFUNDING BONDS AND RELATED MATTERS - RESOLUTION 24-2020

John Bond, County Treasurer, stated that this is to refinance the Animal Shelter bonds (outstanding amount of about \$1.765 million) to save about \$150,000. There were eight outstanding bonds 2-3 years ago and now there are six. The county's aggressive strategy is to pay them off quickly or to refinance them when advantageous. Jonathon Ward, of Zions Public Finance, county's financial advisor, stated that the existing interest rate on the outstanding bonds is 4.97% and based on the current interest rate environment he anticipates to get closer to a 1.4% average. Randy Larsen, of Gilmore & Bell, county bond counsel, briefly outlined the resolution and related contracts.

Commissioner Jenkins moved to adopt Resolution 24-2020 authorizing issuance and sale of not more than \$2,500,000 aggregate principal amount of Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds and related matters; Commissioner Harvey seconded.
