1. MODIFICATION OF INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT #81-00-0014 WITH THE U.S. MARSHALS SERVICE FOR DETENTION AND TRANSPORTATION OF US MARSHAL INMATES.

Steffani Ebert, of the County Sheriff's Office, noted that the county houses inmates for the U.S. Marshals Service and this modification increases the rate from \$65.00/day/inmate to \$78.00/day/inmate. Commissioner Jenkins moved to approve the modification of Intergovernmental Agreement #81-00-0014 for detention and transportation of U.S. Marshal inmates; Commissioner Ebert seconded. Commissioner Ebert – aye; Commissioner Jenkins – aye; Chair Harvey – aye

2. CONTRACT WITH ADMIRAL BEVERAGE CORPORATION, PEPSI COLA BOTTLING OF OGDEN, FOR EXCLUSIVE POURING RIGHTS AT GOLDEN SPIKE EVENT CENTER/WEBER COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS, TEN-YEAR AGREEMENT.

Duncan Olsen, GSEC General Manager, stated that Admiral Beverage was the only bidder. Mr. Olsen addressed Commissioner Jenkins' question on the length of the agreement stating that the county will be compensated very fairly, roughly receiving about \$22,000/year. Mr. Olsen outlined other savings. Chair Harvey noted that other companies have had longer or similar terms and stated that this is a good contract for the county. Commissioner Ebert commended Mr. Olsen, recognizing what Admiral Beverage was willing to do for the exclusive rights, including yearly marketing support for certain county facilities.

Commissioner Jenkins moved to approve the contract with Admiral Beverage Corporation, Pepsi Cola Bottling of Ogden, for exclusive pouring rights at Golden Spike Event Center/Weber County Fairgrounds, tenyear agreement; Commissioner Ebert seconded.
