old fence running N-S East consists of 6" diam. posts w/ wire fence

older cedar posts w/ barbed wire all posts still standing N-S. East

6" diam. posts w/ barbed wire (somewhat new) all are standing metal post w/ barbed wire no. (cedar posts south) East

newer steel posts w/ barbed wire older posts begin 200' East no. fence north (cedar & metal posts south) continues Eastward believed to be here in 1934 East

old cor. post @ Row metal posts w/ wire 80' north Eastward for

newer 1" diam. post @ cor. w/ Row metal posts w/ wire south runs East 1000' ± (6" diam. old posts w/ barbed wire) believed to be here in 1934 (north) mixed older fence

old cor. post cedar w/ barbed wire running south newer 6" diam. posts running west. 4-6" diam. posts running East-cedar;

older cedar posts w/ barbed wire running N-S. & west. 400' ± west in length

6" diam. post running west (somewhat new) mixed cedar & old posts w/ barbed wire N-S. & E.

(metal posts & barbed wire west) mixed metal posts & 6" diam. old posts north

(metal posts & barbed wire west) old wood posts & wire south

older cedar posts w/ barbed wire (fenced for parcel w/ house)

↑ (fences do not extend west beyond 100' ±)

older cedar posts w/ barbed wire (S. side for parcel w/ house)

older cedar posts running south & East

Falls on E. edge 3500 west.
