

Copy of deed from the heirs of John Taylor to the Ogden Milling and Elevator Company, dated January 27-1890 - as follows:
 Beg. at a point 9.31 ch North from the S.W. cor. of the North West Quarter

- ✓ Sec 8-T-5-N-R-1-W, thence North 6.43 ch, S71°30'E 4.30 ch, and to the West side of the State road; thence S38½°W 6.50 ch to the beg. 1.20 a.
- ✓ Also, Beg. at S.E. cor. of N.E. ¼ Sec. 7-T-5-N-R-1-W, 14 4.88 ch, to Mill-race thence N. 28 ¼° E 80.19 ch, along said Mill-race, to ¼ Sec. line, thence S 9.21 ch, to beg.
- Also, Beg. at a point 9.92 ch N. from S.E. cor. of the last named ¼ Sec. W. 1.94 ch, thence N. 10° 30' E, 22.44 ch, S77° 45' E, 1.00 ch, thence S10° 30' W, 13.14 ch, thence S71° 30' E 11.29 ch, to ¼ Sec. line, thence S along said ¼ Sec. line to a point 11.80 ch, N 49° E of the place of beg, thence S 80° W 11.80 ch to the place of beg. Situate in the N.E. ¼ Sec 17 (B) T-5-N-R-1-W.
