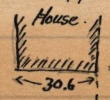


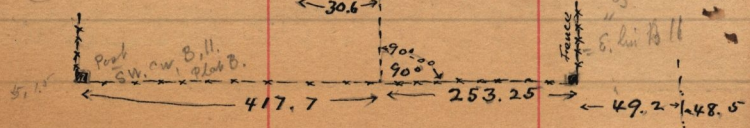

The above measurements were made while the temperature was about zero and to adjust the same to a temp of 68° the table of expansion 0.000066+ should be used which reduces the above measurement of 253.25 or to 253.14 ft.
