

Note: On 3-27-74, we stopped at the Utah State Highway Dept. trailer office in South Weber and talked to David Forsgreen, the Engineer in charge. He showed us a computer printout sheet containing the coordinate values shown on the opposite page. The printout was labelled 212-115-5973 South Weber Conn. Div. 66 10 26 71 Worthen. He suggested that further information might be obtained from Sheldon McKonkie, Location Engineer.

On 3-27-74, I called the State Hwy. Location Engineers office in Salt Lake City, and talked to Carl Christensen, who looked up the computer run in the files, and told me the factor use for the coordinates on the opposite page is 1.0002679. Therefore, I divided these coordinates by that factor, and multiplied the result by 1.0002400 (see page 24 in this book), to obtain figures to check our traverse between South Weber and 21st St. (Incidentally, Utah State Hwy. Engineer in charge of Location and Environmental Studies is Sterling Davis, and the Location Engineer under Mr. Davis is Glen Larson.)

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
