1 Wall and 28th N.E. cor. opened hydrant
and took off cover. Spins exceedingly by hand.
water rusty. Threads O.K. valve box full of sand
cover gone shut off tight. cover chain O.K. (Ludlow) X

2 Wall + 27 N.E. cor. took off cover and
opened hydrant - had to pound on wrench with
rock to open it. Both of us could not start it.
water muddy soon cleared. Threads O.K.
no chains. shut off tight (Ludlow)
valve box cover gone full of sand

3 Wall + 26th N.E. cor. took off cover and opened
hydrant. opened O.K. Threads O.K. no chains,
nuts. Valve box cover O.K. water clear (Ludlow)

From here on the procedure in each
case is to take off cover examine threads &
open and close valve

4 Wall + 25th N.E. cor. Ludlow 3 covers.
Threads O.K. no chains
valve box cover O.K. water muddy shut tight
