

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

March 3.

Section 20, Township 6 North of Range One West - Salt Lake Meridian, and to "County Survey Monument No 4" thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 16.01 chains, to "Monument No. 3" situated in the center of streets leading East and West near the Mounds Fort School House thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 11.21 chains, to "Monument No. 5," situated in the center of a street leading Eastward thence continuing $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 11.26 chains, to "Monument No. 6" situated in the center of streets leading Eastward and Westward through "Lyons District," thence continuing $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 11.01 chains, to "Monument No. 7" situated in the center of a four rod street on the North boundary of "Ogden City Corporation" leading Eastward, being 20.72 chains $S. 0^{\circ} 15' N.$ and 10.50 ch West from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Six North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian - the bearing from said Monument No. 7 to "Observatory Peak" being $S. 115^{\circ} 21' E.$ The total length of said road is 240.10 chains.

Description of a road four rods wide, leading from Main Street in Lyons District near the residence of Robert Miller Eastward to the Mountain.

2. Beginning in the center of Main Street at what is known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No 5 with bearings to Ben Lomond Peak $N. 2^{\circ} 54' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 52^{\circ} 38' E.$ running from thence $S. 89^{\circ} 15' E.$ 117.12 chains, to Monument No 89 - The bearing from said monument to the United States Observatory, at Ogden being $S. 51^{\circ} 03' N.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 41^{\circ} 49' E.$ and to the spire on the dome of the Weber County Court House $S. 35^{\circ} 38' N.$ From this point the said road continues $S. 89^{\circ} 15' E.$ 12.88 chains, to the mountain. The total length of said road being 160.00 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from Main Street in Lyons at Shaw's store, Eastward to the Mountain.

3. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone, situated in the center of Main Street in Lyons District 21.69 chains South and 10.911 chains West from the North East corner of Section 17, Township Six North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian - known and designated as "Weber County Survey Monument No 6" - from which the bearings to Ben Lomond Peak are $N. 3^{\circ} 06' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 48^{\circ} 46' E.$ running thence $S. 89^{\circ} 48' E.$ 99.20 chains to Monument No 88 - situated in the center of a street 4 rods in width intersecting the above described road and bearing

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book C on page 357 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

2. Description of a 4 road wide road leading from Main street in Lynne District, near the residence of Robert Miller, eastward to the mountain: —

Beginning in the center of Main Street at what is known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 5 with bearings to Ben Lommond Peak $N. 2^{\circ} 54' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 52^{\circ} 38' E.$ running from thence $S. 89^{\circ} 45' E.$ 117.12 chains to Monument No. 89. The bearing from said monument to the U. S. observatory at Ogden being $S 51^{\circ} 03' W.$ and to Observatory Peak $S 41^{\circ} 49' E.$ and to the spire on the dome of the County Court House $S. 35^{\circ} 38' W.$ From this point the said road continued $S 89^{\circ} 45' E.$ 42.88 chains to the mountain. The total length of said road being 160.00 chains.
