in Lyme District 21.69 chains South, and 10.94 chains West from the North East corner of Section Seventeen, Township Six North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument Number Six from which the bearings to Benlonsard Peak are $N. 3^{\circ} 06' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 48^{\circ} 46\frac{1}{2}' E.$ running from thence $N. 89^{\circ} 48' N. \frac{5}{10}$ of one chain to what is known as Weber County Survey Monument Number 22 at the intersection of a road leading Northwestward to Harrisville, thence $N. 89^{\circ} 48' N. 162.91$ chains, to Monument Number 80, situated in the center of a road leading Southward to Marnitts Schoolhouse and being 22.63 chains North and 9.51 chains West from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian. The total length of said road to the above point being 163.44 chains.

Description of a County Road six rods wide leading from Shaw's store in Lyme North westward through Harrisville to the Hot Springs.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone, situated $\frac{5}{10}$ of one chain $N. 89^{\circ} 48' N.$ from the center of Main Street near Shaw's store in Lyme District 21.69 chains South and 11.47 chains West from the North East corner of Section Seventeen, Township Six North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument Number Twenty Two (22) running from thence $N. 25^{\circ} 30' N. 68.62$ chains in the center of said street, thence $N. 39^{\circ} 45' N. 8.23$ chains to Weber County Survey Monument No. 23 at the intersection of the center of a road 4 rods in width leading $N. 60^{\circ} E. 11.08$ chains, to the center of Main Street, thence $N. 68^{\circ} N. 1365$ chains, thence $N. 50^{\circ} 25' N. 28.26$ chains, thence $N. 30^{\circ} 35' N. 14.28$ chains to Weber County Survey Monument No. 24 situated $N. 78^{\circ} 18' N.$ from the South East corner of Section Six Township Six North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, running from thence due North 17.93 chains thence $N. 66^{\circ} 30' N. 38.65$ chains to Monument No. 25 situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading to Pleasant View District. Said monument being $S. 35^{\circ} 47' N. 6.16$ chains from the North East corner of the South West Quarter of Section Six Township Six North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, continuing thence $N. 66^{\circ} 30' N. 23.02$ chains to Monument No. 26, thence due West 27.86 chains to Monument No. 27, situated at the intersection of the center of a street four rods in width leading Southward to Slatonville District and to Monument No. 80, thence $S. 87^{\circ} 52' N. 17.90$

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chains, thence $N. 50^{\circ} 28' N.$ 18.20 chains, thence $N. 38^{\circ} 51' N.$ 5.06 chains, thence $N. 11^{\circ} 05' N.$ 5.46 chains, to Monument No. 28, at the center of a street four rods in width leading Westward to Plain City, thence continuing $N. 11^{\circ} 05' N.$ 11.39 chains to Monument No. 29, from which the bearing to Benlmond Peak is $N. 30^{\circ} 32' E.$ thence $N. 57^{\circ} 17' N.$ 51.02 chains to Monument No. 30, situated at the intersection of the center of a street four rods in width leading Southward to Slaterville District said monument being $N. 35^{\circ} 45' N.$ from the Northwest corner of a brick schoolhouse in Harrisonville, thence continuing $N. 0^{\circ} 15' N.$ 81.99 chains, thence $N. 37^{\circ} N.$ 23.13 chains, thence $N. 13^{\circ} 13' N.$ 16.29 chains, thence $N. 16^{\circ} 40' N.$ 17.26 chains to Monument No. 31, situated at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading to Plain City, thence continuing $N. 16^{\circ} 40' N.$ 4.86 chains, thence $N. 28^{\circ} 20' N.$ 18.00 chains, thence $N. 9^{\circ} 40' E.$ 55.00 chains, thence $N. 51^{\circ} 47' E.$ 15.00 chains, crossing the main line of the Central Pacific Railway track, thence $N. 34^{\circ} 31' E.$ 16.88 chains, to the intersection of the center of a road eight rods in width leading South-eastward through Pleasant View District, the above point of intersection being situated $N. 26^{\circ} 45' N.$ 2.60 chains from the Hot Spring declared to be on the boundary line between Weber and Box Elder Counties, by a deputation from each of said Counties on November 5 - 1884 - which point of intersection of roads lies wholly in Box Elder County. The length of said road is 587.44 chains.

Description of a County Road eight rods wide, known as Main Street, leading from the North line of Ogden City Corporation, Northward & Westward to the Hot Springs.

1/2 Beginning at the center of Main Street on the North line of Ogden City Corporation, at a certain monument of sandstone, situated 20.72 chains $S. 0^{\circ} 15' N.$ and 10.50 chains West from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Eight (8) Township Six North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian, and known as Weber County Survey Monument Number 7, the bearing from said monument to Observatory Peak being $S. 44^{\circ} 52' E.$ running from thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 47.511 chains to Monument No. 9 situated at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading $S. 60^{\circ} 15' N.$ to Harrisonville District, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 13.53 chains to Monument No. 8, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 62.66 chains to Monument No. 11, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 30.78 chains, to Monument No. 12, situated at the center of a street leading Westward, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 52.63 chains to Monument No. 14, situated at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading Westward and Southward to Harrisonville, at Monument No. 25 continuing thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 10.57 chains to Monument

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 363-4 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

 situated 53 of one chain N. 89° 48' W. from the center of
 Main Street near Shaws Store in Lynne District 21.69
 chains south and 11.47 chains west from the northeast
 corner of Section 17, Township 6 north of Range One West,
 Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County
 Survey Monument No. 22 running from thence N. 25° 30' W.
 68.62 chains in the center of said street, thence N. 39° 45' W.
 8.23 chains ^{County Survey} Monument No. 23 at the intersection of the
 center of a road 4 rods in width leading N. 60° E. 41.08 chains,
 to the center of Main Street, thence N. 68° W. 13.65 chains, thence
 N. 50° 25' W. 28.76 chains, thence N. 30° 35' W. 14.29 chains to ^{Weber} County
 Monument No. 24, situated N. 78° 18' W. from the southeast

corner of Section 6 Township 6, North of Range One
 West, Salt Lake Meridian, running from thence due
 North, 17.93 chains, thence N. 66° 30' W. 38.65 chains to Mon-
 ument No. 25 situated at the intersection of the center of a
 street leading to Pleasant View District. Said Mon-
 ument being S. 35° 47' W. 6.16 chains from the northeast
 corner of the southwest quarter of Section 6, Town-
 ship 6 North of Range One west, Salt Lake Meridian,
 continuing thence N. 66° 30' W. 23.02 chains to Monument
 No. 26, thence due west 27.86 chains to Monument No.
 27, situated at the intersection of a center of a street four
 rods in width leading southward to Slaterville District,
 and to Monument No. 28, thence S. 87° 52' W. 17.90 chains,
 thence N. 50° 28' W. 18.20 chains, thence N. 38° 51' W. 50.6 chains,
 thence N. 11° 5' W. 5.46 chains to Monument No. 28 at the
 center of a street four rods in width leading west-
 ward to Plain City, thence continuing N. 11° 5' W.
 14.39 chains to Monument No. 29, from which the bearing
 to Ben Lommond Peak is N. 30° 32' E., thence N.
 57° 17' W. 51.02 chains to Monument No. 30, situated
 at the intersection of the center of a street four rods

 Pacific R. R. ^{track} thence N. $34^{\circ}31'$ E. 16.88 chains to the intersection of the
 center of a road eight rods in width leading southward
 through Pleasant View District, the above point of inter-
 section being situated N. $26^{\circ}45'$ W. 2.60 chains, from the
 Hot Springs declared to be on the boundary line between

Weber and Boxelder Counties, by a deputation from each
 of said counties on November 5, 1884 - which point of
 intersection of roads lies wholly in Boxelder County.
 The length of said road being 587.44 chains.
