No. 13, situated at the intersection of the center of a street four rods in width leading Eastward through North Ogden immediately South of the North Ogden meeting-house, continuing thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 35.29 chains to Monument No. 15, situated at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading Eastward near the North Ogden Cemetery, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ 1.40 chains to Monument No. 16, thence $N. 61^{\circ} N.$ 57.86 chains thence $N. 77^{\circ} 05' N.$ 32.57 chains to Monument No. 17, situated at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading North to Pole Patch District, thence continuing $N. 77^{\circ} 05' N.$ 42.70 chains to Monument No. 18, thence $N. 72^{\circ} 15' N.$ 18.90 chains to Monument No. 19, situated at the intersection of the center of a street four rods in width leading Southward to Harrisville District thence continuing $N. 72^{\circ} 15' N.$ 10.15 chains, thence $N. 53^{\circ} 30' N.$ 3.28 chains to Monument No. 20 at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to "Pole Patch" and the boundary line of Weber County, thence continuing $N. 53^{\circ} 30' N.$ 31.04 chains, thence $N. 64^{\circ} 30' N.$ 26.17 chains, thence $N. 59^{\circ} 47' N.$ 10.35 chains, thence $N. 114^{\circ} 25' N.$ 31.16 chains, thence $N. 48^{\circ} 30' N.$ 18.53 chains to the intersection of the center of a street leading Eastward to Pole Patch District thence continuing $N. 48^{\circ} 30' N.$ 19.87 chains, thence $N. 21^{\circ} 52' N.$ 1.09 chains to the point of the intersection of a road six rods in width leading Southwestward through Harrisville. The above point of intersection being situated $N. 26^{\circ} 45' N.$ 2.60 chains from the Hot Spring declared to be on the boundary line between Weber and Box Elder Counties, by a deputation from each of the above named Counties, authorized to establish the boundary line November 5, 1884, which point of intersection of roads lies wholly in Box Elder County. The length of the above described road is 552.37 chains from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point in Main Street North from Lynne District Southwestward to the road through Harrisville.

15. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of what is known as Main Street, 10.50 chains West, and 26.82 chains $N. 0^{\circ} 15' E.$ from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Eight, Township Six North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 9, running from thence $S. 60^{\circ} 15' N.$ 41.08 chains, to Monument No. 23, at the intersection of the center of the broad street leading Northwestward through Harrisville. Said road being 41.08 chains in length.

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 365 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

15. From a point in Main St. to a road through Harrisville:-
 Beginning at a certain Monument of sandstone situated in the center of what is known as Main Street, 10.5 chains West, and N. 8¹/₂ chains N. 15' E. from the south ^{west} corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 6 North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, Town and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 9 running from thence S. 60° 15' W. 41.08 chains to Monument No. 23 at the intersection of the center of the cross street leading Northwestward through Harrisville. Said road being 41.08 chains in length.
