

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

1885

March 3.

West and $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain North from the Northwest corner of Block No. 36, North Ogden Survey, Plat "A" known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 15. the bearing to Benlounod Peak being N. 6° 04' E. - running from thence due East 75.00 chains to Monument No. 46 at the intersection of the center of a road four rods in width leading Northward to the mountains, thence continuing S. 87° 11.11' E. 40.75 chains, to the quarter section line running North and South in section Twenty Eight (28) Township Seven North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian and to the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward. The above described road being 48.55 chains in length from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Northward from a point near the Cemetery in North Ogden.

24. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of said road $\frac{80}{100}$ of one chain East and $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain North from the Northeast corner of Block No. 36 - Plat "A" North Ogden Survey, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 46. the bearing to Benlounod Peak being N. 4° 32' E. and to the South gable of the North Ogden meeting house S. 33° 37' E. - running from thence due North 246.77 chains, and to the North line of section Eight in Township Seven North of Range One West of Salt Lake Meridian. Said road being 246.77 chains in length.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of Colarks in North Ogden Northwestward to a point near Randle in North Ogden.

25. Beginning at a point 8.55 chains due East and 22.93 chains S. 13° 10' N. from the Northwest corner of section Three (3) Township Six North of Range One West Salt Lake Meridian and in the center of the street leading Southward to Ogden City. the bearing from said point to Benlounod Peak being N. 8° 31' N. running from thence N. 3° 21' E. 7.60 chains thence N. 40° 45' N. 2.82 chains, thence N. 76° 06' N. 6.04 chains, thence N. 0° 24' N. 5.77 chains, thence N. 54° 42' N. 3.31 chains, thence N. 2° 40' E. 15.91 chains, thence N. 20° 32' N. 1.87 chains, thence North 8.56 chains, to Weber County Survey Monument No. 11, in the center of a street running East and West the bearing to Benlounod Peak being N. 8° 04' N. The total length of the above road being 51.88 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from Pleasant View Northward to Pole Patch, and Westward to the Hot Springs.

26. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street eight

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roads six widths leading Northwestward through Pleasant View District, near the residence of Edward Wade, said monument being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 17, from which the bearing to Benlornond Peak is $N. 24^{\circ} 33' E$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 34^{\circ} 31' E$, and to Eyrie Peak $S. 52^{\circ} 10' E$ - running from thence due North 91.45 chains, thence $N. 65^{\circ} 05' W$ 5.110 chains to the North line of Section Nineteen (19) Township Seven North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence $S 89^{\circ} 19' W$ 48.14 chains to the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to the North boundary line of Weber County, thence continuing $S 89^{\circ} 19' W$ 114.67 chains to the intersection of the center of the Main Street eight rods in width leading to the Hot Springs. Said road is 359.66 chains in length.

Description of a County Road two rods wide leading from Pleasant View District - Northward to the Northern boundary line of Weber County.

27. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the Main Street eight rods in width leading from Pleasant View Northwestward to the Hot Springs 6.72 chains $N. 34^{\circ} 42' E$ and 328 chains $N. 53^{\circ} 30' W$ from the south west corner of Section Nineteen (19) Township Seven North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 20, the bearing to Benlornond Peak being $N. 37^{\circ} 39' E$, running from thence $N. 23^{\circ} 28' E$ 28.90 chains, thence $N. 30^{\circ} 53' E$ 15.88 chains, thence $N. 3^{\circ} 30' E$ 17.94 chains, thence $N. 6^{\circ} 18' W$ 15.28 chains to the intersection of a road leading Westward to the Hot Springs, thence due North 43.00 chains, thence $N. 6^{\circ} 12' E$ 33.28 chains, and to a monument of stone situated in the vicinity of the Northern boundary line of Weber County. The bearing from said point to Benlornond Peak being $N. 65^{\circ} 06' E$. Magnetic azimuth being $N. 17^{\circ} 08' E$. The total length of said road being 154.28 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of Aul Thomas in Blaterville District and running Northward to Harrisville District.

28. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Eastward to Lyman District being 22.63 chains North, and 9.51 chains West from the South East corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 80, the bearing to Benlornond Peak being $N. 18^{\circ} 45' E$, running from thence due North 41.32 chains, thence $N. 1^{\circ} 00' E$ 103.68 chains, to Monument No. 27 situated in the intersection of the center of the street six rods in

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 on page 467-40 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

26. From Pleasant View to Pole Patch and Hot Springs.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street, eight rods in width leading north-westward through Pleasant View, near the ruins of Edward Wade, said monument being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 17, from which the bearing to Ben Leonard Peak is N. $24^{\circ}33'E$. and to Observatory Peak S. $34^{\circ}31'E$. and to Eyrie Peak S. $52^{\circ}10'E$, running from thence due North 91.45 chains, thence N. $61^{\circ}05'S$. 5.40 chains, to the north line of Section 19, Township 7 North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence S. $89^{\circ}19'S$. 48.14 chains to the intersection of the center of a road leading northward to the north boundary line of Weber County, thence ^{259.66 chains to intersection of the center of street leading northward to Hot Springs} continuing S. $89^{\circ}19'S$. 114.67 chains to the intersection of the center of a Main Street, eight rods wide leading to the Hot Springs. Said road is 259.66 chains long.
