roads six widths leading Northwestward through Pleasant View District, near the residence of Edward Wade, said monument being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 17, from which the bearing to Benlornond Peak is $N. 24^{\circ} 33' E$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 34^{\circ} 31' E$, and to Eyrie Peak $S. 52^{\circ} 10' E$ - running from thence due North 91.45 chains, thence $N. 65^{\circ} 05' W. 5.110$ chains to the North line of Section Nineteen (19) Township Seven North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence $S 89^{\circ} 19' W. 48.14$ chains to the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to the North boundary line of Weber County, thence continuing $S 89^{\circ} 19' W. 114.67$ chains to the intersection of the center of the Main Street eight rods in width leading to the Hot Springs. Said road is 359.66 chains in length.

Description of a County Road two rods wide leading from Pleasant View District - Northward to the Northern boundary line of Weber County.

27. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the Main Street eight rods in width leading from Pleasant View Northwestward to the Hot Springs 6.72 chains $N. 34^{\circ} 42' E$ and 3.28 chains $N. 53^{\circ} 30' W$ from the south west corner of Section Nineteen (19) Township Seven North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 20, the bearing to Benlornond Peak being $N. 37^{\circ} 39' E$, running from thence $N. 23^{\circ} 28' E. 28.90$ chains, thence $N. 30^{\circ} 53' E. 15.88$ chains, thence $N. 3^{\circ} 30' E. 17.94$ chains, thence $N. 6^{\circ} 18' W. 15.28$ chains to the intersection of a road leading Westward to the Hot Springs, thence due North 43.00 chains, thence $N. 6^{\circ} 12' E. 33.28$ chains, and to a monument of stone situated in the vicinity of the Northern boundary line of Weber County. The bearing from said point to Benlornond Peak being $N. 65^{\circ} 06' E$. Magnetic azimuth being $N. 17^{\circ} 08' E$. The total length of said road being 154.28 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of Aul Thomas in Blaterville District and running Northward to Harrisville District.

28. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Eastward to Lynne District being 22.63 chains North, and 9.51 chains West from the South East corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 80, the bearing to Benlornond Peak being $N. 18^{\circ} 45' E$, running from thence due North 41.32 chains, thence $N. 1^{\circ} 00' E. 103.68$ chains, to Monument No. 27 situated in the intersection of the center of the street six rods in

width leading Southeastward through Harrisville. Bearings from said monument to Benlomonad Peak being $N. 21^{\circ} 22' E.$ The length of said road being 115.00 chains from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of Daniel Thomas in Slaterville Northwestward through Slaterville to Plain City.

29. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of a street leading Southward to Marriottville Schoolhouse, and being 22.63 chains North $89^{\circ} 51'$ chains West from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section Thirteen in Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 80. the bearing from said monument to Benlomonad Peak being $N. 18^{\circ} 45' E.$ running from thence $N. 89^{\circ} 18' W. 30.64$ chains, thence North 20.42 chains, thence $N. 89^{\circ} 30' W. 10.45$ chains, to Monument No. 85, situated at the intersection of a street leading Northward and Westward in Slaterville, bearings from said monument to Benlomonad Peak being $N. 23^{\circ} 10' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 58^{\circ} 58' E.$ and to Egie Peak $N. 77^{\circ} 10\frac{1}{2}' E.$ thence continuing $N. 89^{\circ} 30' W. 29.42$ chains, thence $N. 77^{\circ} W. 20.90$ chains, thence $S. 86^{\circ} W. 8.04$ chains to Monument No. 83, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading South and Eastward to Marriottville and being near the Slaterville schoolhouse - bearings being to Benlomonad Peak $N. 28^{\circ} 10' E.$ and to Egie Peak $N. 79^{\circ} 13' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 61^{\circ} 07\frac{1}{2}' E.$ running from thence $N. 8^{\circ} E. 26.11$ chains to Monument No. 84, situated at the intersection of a street leading Eastward and Northward to Harrisville, being near the residence of Henry Bowns in Slaterville, bearings to Benlomonad Peak $N. 29^{\circ} 02' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 59^{\circ} 13' E.$ and to the South gable of the North Ogden meetinghouse $N. 54^{\circ} 32\frac{1}{2}' E.$ running from thence $N. 74^{\circ} 50' W. 58.27$ chains, thence $N. 56^{\circ} 50' W. 25.07$ chains, thence $N. 46^{\circ} 10' W. 18.57$ chains, thence $N. 54^{\circ} W. 18.49$ chains, thence due West 13.36 chains, thence $N. 80^{\circ} 45' W. 15.72$ chains, thence due North 8.35 chains, thence $N. 72^{\circ} 27' W. 43.13$ chains, thence due North 9.97 chains, thence due West 11.89 chains, thence $N. 39^{\circ} W. 7.68$ chains, thence $N. 76^{\circ} W. 7.64$ chains, to Monument No. 87, bearings to Benlomonad Peak $N. 48^{\circ} 55' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 60^{\circ} 25\frac{1}{2}' E.$ to Egie Peak $S. 87^{\circ} 06' E.$ and to the center of Section Four Township Six North of Range Two West Salt Lake Meridian, $S. 72^{\circ} E.$

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book,
 on page 370-1 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Staterville to Harrisville.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of a street, leading eastward to Lyman District, being 22.63 chains north and 9.51 chains West from the southeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 13 Township 6, North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 80, the bearing to Ben Leonard Peak being $N. 18^{\circ} 45' E.$ running from thence due north 41.92 chains, thence $N. 1^{\circ} E.$ 103.68 chains, to Monument No. 27, situated in the intersection of the center of the street, six rods in width leading southeastward through Harrisville. Bearing from said Monument to Ben Leonard Peak being, $N. 24^{\circ} 22' E.$ The length of said road being 145 chains from its beginning to this point.
