

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

244.85 chains running from thence $N. 18^{\circ} 20' E.$ 111.03 chains, thence West 21.07 chains, thence due North 7.48 chains, thence West 9.48 chains, thence North 11.38 chains, thence West 2.47 chains, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 27' E.$ 9.59 chains, to Monument No. 37, situated $\frac{1}{100}$ of one chain South and $\frac{1}{100}$ of one chain West from the South West corner of Lot Ten, Plat "B" Plain City Survey bearings to Benlornond Peak being $N. 53^{\circ} 27' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S 89^{\circ} 01\frac{1}{2}' E.$ and to Egypt Peak $S 83^{\circ} 41\frac{1}{2}' E.$ and in the center of a street leading Eastward to Harrisville. The total length of said road being 457.62 chains from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of William Price in Harrisville, Westward through Slaterville to the Slaterville schoolhouse.

30. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of a road leading Northward to Slaterville and Lyman District. The bearings from said monument being: to Benlornond Peak $N. 17^{\circ} 42' E.$ and to Egypt Peak $N. 66^{\circ} 41' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S 62^{\circ} 21\frac{1}{2}' E.$ and to the United States Observatory at Ogden $S 20^{\circ} 17' E.$ and to the South East corner of Section Thirteen Township Six North of Range Six West Salt Lake Meridian $S 30^{\circ} 12' E.$ said monument being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 79, running thence $N. 89^{\circ} 57' N.$ 80.38 chains to Monument No. 81, thence due North 18.06 chains, thence $N. 78^{\circ} N.$ 10.34 chains, thence due North 19.20 chains, thence $N. 74^{\circ} 20' N.$ 3.24 chains, thence $N. 42^{\circ} N.$ 5.21 chains thence $N. 89^{\circ} 51' N.$ 3.65 chains, to Monument No. 82, situated in the center of a street leading Westward, thence $N. 1^{\circ} 30' E.$ 22.62 chains, thence $N. 65^{\circ} E.$ 3.20 chains, thence $N. 8^{\circ} 29' E.$ 3.48 chains, to Monument No. 83, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward and Westward through Slaterville, and being near the Slaterville schoolhouse. The bearings from said monument being, to Benlornond Peak $N. 28^{\circ} 10' E.$, to Egypt Peak $N 79^{\circ} 13' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S 61^{\circ} 07\frac{1}{2}' E.$ The total length of said road being 166.38 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from a point near the residence of John Alfred, in Slaterville District, and running North and Westward to County Survey Monument No. 84, near the residence of Henry Boush in Slaterville.

31. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Northwestward through Slaterville to Plain City, near the residence of John Alfred in Slaterville, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 85. The bearings from said monument being as follows: to Benlornond Peak

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N. $23^{\circ} 10' E$, to Egrie Peak N. $77^{\circ} 10\frac{1}{2}' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $58^{\circ} 58' E$ running from thence due North 21.33 chains, thence N. $89^{\circ} 30' N$. 29.01 chains, thence due North 5.69 chains, thence N. $81^{\circ} N$. 10.51 chains, and to Monument No. 86, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to Harrisville, thence N. $84^{\circ} 43\frac{1}{2}' N$. 14.87 chains, to Monument No. 84, situated at the intersection of the center of the Main Street leading Northwestward through Slaterville to Plain City, and near the residence of Henry Brown in Slaterville. The bearings from said monument being: to Benlmond Peak N. $29^{\circ} 52' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $57^{\circ} 13' E$, and to the South gable of the North Ogden meeting house N. $54^{\circ} 32\frac{1}{2}' E$. The length of said road being 81.41 chains, from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from the residence of Smoot in Slaterville Northward to intersect the road from Harrisville to the Hot Springs

32. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Southeastward from Slaterville, and near the residences of the Smoots in Slaterville, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 86. - the bearings from said monument being as follows: to Benlmond Peak N. $27^{\circ} 48' E$, to Egrie Peak N. $81^{\circ} 57' E$, and to Observatory Peak S. $58^{\circ} 36' E$ running from thence N. $0^{\circ} 13' E$. 115.09 chains, to Monument No. 33, situated at the intersection of a street leading Westward to Plain City, thence N. $0^{\circ} 37' E$. 41.28 chains, to Monument No. 39, situated at the intersection of the center of a street six rods in width leading Northward to the Hot Springs and being near the school-house in the Western part of Harrisville. The bearings from said monument are, to Benlmond Peak N. $36^{\circ} 55' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $49^{\circ} E$ and to the Northwest corner of the school-house above named S. $35^{\circ} 45' E$. The above described road is 156.37 chains in length.

Description of a County Road partly four rods wide leading from Harrisville, Westward to Plain City.

33. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of Main Street leading Northward from Harrisville to the Hot Springs, and near the residence of William Reason in Harrisville, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 28, the bearing to Benlmond Peak being N. $29^{\circ} 22' E$ of to

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 9th
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 572-3 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

31. From the residence of John Allred to that of Henry Downs in Platons
 Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in
 the center of the street leading northward through
 Slaterville to Plain City, near the residence of John Allred
 known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument
 No. 85, the bearing from said monument being as follows:—
 To Ben Leonard Peak N. $23^{\circ}10'$ E. to Eagle Peak N. $77^{\circ}10\frac{1}{2}'$ E,
 to Observatory Peak S. $58^{\circ}58'$ E. running from thence due
 north 71.33 chains, thence N. $89^{\circ}30'$ W. 29.01 chains, thence due
 north 5.69 chains, thence N. $81^{\circ}24'$ W. 10.51 chains, and to monument
 No. 86, situated at the intersection of the center of a street
 leading northward to Harrisville, thence N. $84^{\circ}43\frac{1}{2}'$ W. 14.87
 chains, to monument No. 84, situated at the intersection of the
 center of the Main Street leading northward through
 Slaterville to Plain City and near the residence of
 Henry Downs in Slaterville. The bearings from said
 monument to Ben Leonard Peak being N. $29^{\circ}2'$ E. to
 Observatory Peak S. $59^{\circ}13'$ E. and to the south gable of
 the North Ogden Meeting house N. $54^{\circ}32\frac{1}{2}'$ E. The
 length of said road is 81.41 chains.
