

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

N. $23^{\circ} 10' E$, to Egrie Peak N. $77^{\circ} 10\frac{1}{2}' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $58^{\circ} 58' E$ running from thence due North 21.33 chains, thence N. $89^{\circ} 30' N$. 29.01 chains, thence due North 5.69 chains, thence N. $81^{\circ} N$. 10.51 chains, and to Monument No. 86, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to Harrisville, thence N. $84^{\circ} 43\frac{1}{2}' N$. 14.87 chains, to Monument No. 84, situated at the intersection of the center of the Main Street leading Northwestward through Slaterville to Plain City, and near the residence of Henry Brown in Slaterville. The bearings from said monument being: to Benlmond Peak N. $29^{\circ} 52' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $57^{\circ} 13' E$, and to the South gable of the North Ogden meeting house N. $54^{\circ} 32\frac{1}{2}' E$. The length of said road being 81.41 chains, from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from the residence of Smoot in Slaterville Northward to intersect the road from Harrisville to the Hot Springs

32. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Southeastward from Slaterville, and near the residences of the Smoots in Slaterville, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 86. - the bearings from said monument being as follows: to Benlmond Peak N. $27^{\circ} 48' E$, to Egrie Peak N. $81^{\circ} 57' E$, and to Observatory Peak S. $58^{\circ} 36' E$ running from thence N. $0^{\circ} 13' E$. 115.09 chains, to Monument No. 33, situated at the intersection of a street leading Westward to Plain City, thence N. $0^{\circ} 37' E$. 41.28 chains, to Monument No. 39, situated at the intersection of the center of a street six rods in width leading Northward to the Hot Springs and being near the school-house in the Western part of Harrisville. The bearings from said monument are, to Benlmond Peak N. $36^{\circ} 55' E$, to Observatory Peak S. $49^{\circ} E$ and to the Northwest corner of the school-house above named S. $35^{\circ} 45' E$. The above described road is 156.37 chains in length.

Description of a County Road partly four rods wide leading from Harrisville, Westward to Plain City.

33. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of Main Street leading Northward from Harrisville to the Hot Springs, and near the residence of William Reason in Harrisville, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 28, the bearing to Benlmond Peak being N. $29^{\circ} 22' E$ of to

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the Southwest corner of William Rawson's adobe house $S 31^{\circ} 06' E$ running from thence $N 89^{\circ} 30' W$ 116.12 chains to Monument No. 33 at the intersection of the center of a street leading Southward to Slaterville District, thence continuing $N 89^{\circ} 30' W$ 30.91 chains, thence due North 13.42 chains, thence $S 89^{\circ} 55' W$ 65.65 chains, to Monument No. 34, thence $N 1^{\circ} 30' E$ 7.48 chains to Monument No. 35 at the center of the street six rods in width beginning at this point, thence $N 89^{\circ} 17' W$ 66.87 chains in the center of the street six rods in width, to Monument No. 36, situated at the intersection of a street four rods in width leading Northward and Westward to Plain City, thence continuing $N 89^{\circ} 17' W$ 81.20 chains in the center of said street six rods in width, and to Monument No. 37 at the intersection of a street leading Southeastward to Slaterville, and being near the Southwest corner of the Plain City Cemetery, being $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain South and $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain West from the Southwest corner of Lot No. Ten, Plat "B", ^{in Weber County, Utah,} Plain City Survey. The bearings from said monument being: to Benlornond Peak $N 53^{\circ} 27' E$, to Egrie Peak $S 83^{\circ} 41\frac{1}{2}' E$ and to Observatory Peak $S 59^{\circ} 05\frac{1}{2}' E$ - running thence $N 0^{\circ} 27' E$ 43.00 chains in the center of a street four rods in width and to Monument No. 38, situated $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain North, $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain West from the Northwest corner of Block No. Eight Plat "A", Plain City Survey, thence $S 89^{\circ} E$ 7.45 chains thence $N 0^{\circ} 27' E$ 22.47 chains, thence $S 89^{\circ} E$ 7.50 chains to the center of the street leading Southward on the East side of Plain City Plat "A", thence $N 0^{\circ} 27' E$ 7.49 chains to Monument No. 39, situated at the intersection of a road leading to the Hot Springs being 3.50 chains due East and 17.5 chains $N 0^{\circ} 27' E$ from the South West corner of Section Twenty Eight, in Township Seven North, of Range Six West, Salt Lake Meridian. The bearing from said monument to Egrie Peak is $S 77^{\circ} 25' E$. The total length of the above described road is 397.51 chains from its beginning to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Southward to the East side of Plat "A", Plain City Survey.

34. Beginning at a point in the center of said street $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain South and $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain East from the South East corner of Block No. Nineteen, Plat "A", Plain City Survey and running from thence $S 0^{\circ} 27' W$ 111.83 chains, to the center of a street leading Eastward and Westward in Plain City, thence $S 89^{\circ} 20' E$ 66.46 chains, thence $S 0^{\circ} 30' W$ 21.25 chains, to Monument No. 36, situated at the intersection of the center of a street six

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the ^{3rd} day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book C on page 373-4 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Harrisville to Plain City.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone, situated in the center of Main Street leading northward from Harrisville to Hot Springs and near the residence of Stth Rawson in Harrisville, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 28, the bearing to Benloman Peak being $N. 29^{\circ} 22' E.$ and to the southwest corner of Stth Rawson's adobe house $S 34^{\circ} 6' E.$ running from thence $N. 89^{\circ} 30' S. 46.12$ chains to Monument No. 33 at the intersection of the center of a street leading southward to Slaterville District, thence continuing $N. 89^{\circ} 30' S. 91$ chains, thence due north 13.42 chains, thence $S. 89^{\circ} 55' S. 65.65$ chains, to Monument No. 32 thence $N. 1^{\circ} 30' E. 7.48$ chains to Monument No. 35 at the center of the street 6 rods wide beginning at this point, thence $N. 89^{\circ} 17' S. 66.57$ chains in the center of the street 6 rods in width, and to Monument No. 36, situated at the intersection of a street four rods in width leading northward and westward to Plain City, thence continuing $N. 89^{\circ} 17' S. 81.20$ chains, in the center of said street six rods in width, and to Monument No. 37 at the intersection of a street leading southeastward to Slaterville and being near the southwest corner of the Plain City Cemetery, being $.75$ of one chain south and $.50$ of one chain west from the southwest corner of Lot No. 10, Plat "B," in Weber County Utah in Plain City Survey. The bearing from said monument being: - to Benloman Peak $N. 53^{\circ} 27' E.$, to Eyriv Peak $S. 83^{\circ} 41\frac{1}{2}' E.$ and to Observatory Peak $S. 59^{\circ} 5\frac{1}{2}' E.$ running thence $N. 27' E. 43$ chains, in the center of street ^{four rods in width} and to Monument No. 38, situated ^{$.50$ of one chain north} west from the Northwest Corner of Block No. 8, Plat "A," Plain City Survey, thence $S. 89^{\circ} E. 7.45$ chains, thence $N. 27' E. 22.47$ chains, thence $S. 89^{\circ} E. 7.50$ chains, to the center of the street leading southward on the East side of Plain City Plat "A" thence $N. 27' E. 7.49$ chains, to Monument No. 39, situated at the intersection of a road leading to the Hot Springs, being 3.50 chains due east and 1.75 chains $N. 27' E.$ from the southwest corner of Section 28 in Township 7 North Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian. The bearing from said Monument to Eyriv Peak is $S. 77^{\circ} 25' E.$ The total length of the said road is 399.51 chains.
