Plain City Survey, being 3.50 chains due East and 1.75 chains  $N. 0^{\circ} 27' E.$  from the South West corner of Section No. Twenty Eight, Township Seven North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 39. The bearings from said monument being as follows: to Egypt Peak  $S. 77^{\circ} 25' E.$  running from thence  $S. 89^{\circ} 33' E.$  7.62 chains, thence  $N. 0^{\circ} 27' E.$  9.72 chains, to the intersection of a road four rods in width leading Northward to the County boundary line, thence  $S. 89^{\circ} 16' E.$  38.10 chains, to Monument No. 40, thence North 5.98 chains, thence  $N. 49^{\circ} 36' E.$  14.06 chains, thence  $N. 80^{\circ} 20' E.$  21.25 chains, thence  $N. 74^{\circ} 10' E.$  6.06 chains, thence  $N. 50^{\circ} 43' E.$  15.85 chains, thence  $N. 44^{\circ} 26' E.$  14.21 chains, thence  $N. 27^{\circ} 35' E.$  14.01 chains, thence  $N. 89^{\circ} 43' E.$  19.15 chains, thence  $S. 78^{\circ} 47' E.$  7.78 chains, thence  $N. 61^{\circ} 13' E.$  26.40 chains, thence  $N. 42^{\circ} 27' E.$  4.85 chains, thence  $N. 88^{\circ} 55' E.$  39.18 chains, to Monument No. 31, situated at the intersection of the center of a street six rods width leading Southward to Harrisville District, being 32.28 chains  $S. 85^{\circ} 23' N.$  from the North East corner of Section No. Twenty six, Township Seven North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian - the bearing to Boulmond Peak being  $N. 51^{\circ} 34' E.$  and to Observatory Peak  $S. 43^{\circ} 59' E.$  The length of said road being 214.52 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Northward from Plain City intersecting the boundary line of Weber County, West from the Hot Springs.

Beginning at a point in the center of the street leading from Plain City to the Hot Springs 11.12 chains due East and 11.12 chains  $N. 0^{\circ} 27' E.$  from the South West corner of Section No. Twenty Eight, Township Seven North, of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, running from thence  $N. 0^{\circ} 27' E.$  12.17 chains, thence  $N. 10^{\circ} 50' E.$  15.50 chains, thence  $N. 27^{\circ} 10' E.$  9.95 chains, thence  $N. 31^{\circ} 47\frac{1}{2}' E.$  5.85 chains, thence  $N. 25^{\circ} 56' E.$  82.50 chains, and to the Northern boundary line of Weber County. ## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the <sup>3rd</sup>  
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
 on page 375 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Plain City, to Hot Springs: -

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading southward on the east side of Plat "A", Plain City Survey, being 3.50 chains due east and 1.75 chains N<sup>o</sup> 27' E. from the southwest corner of Section No. 28, Township 7 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 39 - the bearing from said monument being as follows: - to Byrne Peak S. 77° 25' E. running from thence S. 89° 33' E. 7.62 chains, thence N<sup>o</sup> 27' E. 9.72 chains, to the intersection of the road four rods in width leading northward to the County Boundary line, thence S. 89° 16' E. 38.10 chains to Monument No. 40, thence north 5.98 chains, thence N.

49° 36' E. 14.06 chains, thence N. 80° 20' E. 21.25 chains, thence N. 74° 10' E. 6.06 chains, thence N. 50° 43' E. 15.85 chains, thence N. 44° 26' E. 14.21 chains, thence N. 27° 35' E. 14.01 chains, thence N. 89° 43' E. 19.15 chains, thence S. 78° 47' E. 7.78 chains, thence N. 61° 13' E. 26.41 chains, thence N. 42° 27' E. 4.85 chains, thence N. 88° 53' E. 39.48 chains, to Monument No. 31, situated at the intersection of the center of a street six rods in width leading southward to Harrisville District, being 32.28 chains S. 85° 23' E. from the northeast corner of section 26, Township 7, north of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian - the bearings to Redmond Peak N. 51° 34' E. and to Observatory Peak S. 43° 59' E. The length of said road being 244.52 chains.
