

## Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

chains, thence  $S. 64^{\circ} 02' E.$  2.68 chains, thence  $S. 4^{\circ} 50' N.$  10.81 chains, thence  $S. 69^{\circ} 31' E.$  8.83 chains, to the intersection of the center of a street leading Southward to the railway station at Uintah, thence continuing  $S. 69^{\circ} 31' E.$   $\frac{83}{100}$  of one chain, thence  $S. 83^{\circ} 23' E.$  20.62 chains, thence  $S. 89^{\circ} E.$  11.38 chains, thence  $S. 1^{\circ} N.$  7.93 chains, to a point in the center of a road which leads  $S. 1^{\circ} N.$  7.43 chains, thence  $S. 85^{\circ} 30' E.$  26.88 chains, thence due South 29.26 chains, to the channel of the Weber River, which forms part of the Southern boundary line of Weber County, in Uintah District. The total length of the above road is 529.81 chains.

Description of a County Road two rods wide leading out of the main road which leads to Uintah, South to the Railway Station at Uintah.

- 38 Beginning at a point 21.73 chains West and 1.32 chains South from the North East corner of Section Twenty Seven Township Five North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which point the bearing to the West gable of the school house at Uintah is  $S. 75^{\circ} 20' E.$  - running from thence due South in the center of said road 13.87 chains, thence West 2.25 chains, thence South 2.30 chains, to a point on the South side of the Railway Station at Uintah. Said road being 17.42 chains in length.

Description of a County Road eight rods wide leading Southward from Ogden City, through Riverdale District and to the Southern boundary line of Weber County.

- 39 Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of Main Street in the Southern part of Ogden City 12.16 chains West and 11.89 chains North from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section No. Five, Township Five North, of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 48, at the South end of the Weber County base. The dimensions of said monument are  $8' \times 8' 11.8'$ ; - the bearings from said monument being as follows: to Observatory Peak  $N. 89^{\circ} 52' E.$  to Benlornond Peak  $N. 2^{\circ} 08' E.$ , to the spire on the Weber County Court House  $N. 2^{\circ} 49' E.$  and to the U. S. Observatory  $N. 43^{\circ} 04' N.$  running from thence  $S. 37^{\circ} 48' N.$  45.16 chains, to Monument No. 52, situated at the intersection of a street four rods in width leading Southeastward to the Ogden City Hospital, thence continuing  $S. 37^{\circ} 48' N.$  42.10 chains, to the intersection of the center of a street four rods in width leading Westward near the

## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the <sup>3<sup>rd</sup></sup>  
 day of June A. D. 18<sup>85</sup> (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
 on page 377 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Main County Road in Mintak to Station:-  
 Beginning at a point 21.72 chains West and 1.32  
 south from the northeast corner of Section 27, Township  
 5 North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, from  
 which point the bearing to the west gable of the School-  
 house at Mintak is S. 75° 20' E. running from thence  
 due south in the center of said road 12.87 chains, thence  
 West, 9.25 chains, thence South 2.30 chains, to a point on  
 the south side of the Railway Station at Mintak; said  
 road being 17.42 chains in length.
