

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

Thirty Two 362.77 chains to Monument No. 63, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward from Hooper to West Weber District, and near the North West corner of the North East Quarter of Section No Thirty Two Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, said corner not having been found at the time this road was surveyed. The bearings from the above named monument are as follows: to Observatory Peak $S 83^{\circ} 17' E$. to Eyrie Peak $N 64^{\circ} 51' E$. to Ben Leonard Peak $N 34^{\circ} 23' E$. The total length of the said road is 362.77 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Southwestward from Ogden City, to Hooperville District.

45. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the said street 300 chains due East from the North West corner of Section No Thirty One Township Six North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No 62, the bearings from said monument are as follows: to Observatory Peak $S 78^{\circ} 38' E$. - to Eyrie Peak $N 46^{\circ} 07' E$. and to Ben Leonard Peak $N 12^{\circ} 49\frac{1}{2}' E$, running from thence $S 42^{\circ} 40' N 108.85$ chains parallel to and $8\frac{1}{2}$ feet distant on the West side from the Utah Central Railway track, to the South line of section Thirty Six, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence due West 89.53 chains to the South West corner of Section No Thirty Five in the above named Township and Range, thence South 40.00 chains, thence West 70.04 chains, thence $S 2.8^{\circ} 53\frac{1}{2}' N 46.30$ chains, to a point 13.00 chains West from the South East corner of Section Four Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence West 27.00 chains, thence South 20.00 chains, thence West 20.08 chains, thence South 20.01 chains, thence West 19.48 chains, thence South 40.60 chains, to the South East corner of Section No Eight Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which the bearings are as follows: to Observatory Peak $N 80^{\circ} 40' E$. to Eyrie Peak $N 49^{\circ} 22' E$. and to Ben Leonard Peak $N 25^{\circ} 56' E$. thence $S 89^{\circ} 45' N 39.50$ chains to the center of a road leading Northward to West Weber District - being $\frac{53}{100}$ of one chain due East from the South West corner of the South East Quarter of Section Eight Township Five North of

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Range Six West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence $S 0^{\circ} 01' N$ 67.80 chains to the intersection of a road four rods in width leading Eastward from Hooper District. The bearings from said point are as follows: to Observatory Peak $N 76^{\circ} 50' \frac{1}{2} E$, to Eyrie Peak $N 47^{\circ} 51' E$, to Benlornond Peak $N 26^{\circ} 15' E$. thence due West 40.40 chains to the intersection of the center of a street running North through the Eastern part of Hooper District, thence continuing West 82.08 chains to the intersection of the center of a street leading North and South on the East side of Plat "A" Hooper City Survey; the bearing to Observatory Peak being $N 78^{\circ} 25' E$; from this point Westward for about one half mile the said road is six rods in width, thence due West 82.10 chains to the center of the street running North and South near the schoolhouse in the Western part of Hooper District, from which point the bearing to Observatory Peak is $N 77^{\circ} 16' E$ and to Eyrie Peak $N 54^{\circ} 57' E$, thence continuing West 81.90 chains to the intersection of the center of a street running North & South in the Western part of Hooper near the Eastern shore of the Great Salt Lake, the bearings from the said point being as follows: to Observatory Peak $N 80^{\circ} E$, to Benlornond Peak $N 37^{\circ} E$, thence continuing due West 28.70 chains to the Eastern shore of the Great Salt Lake, from which point the bearings were taken as follows: to Observatory Peak $N 80^{\circ} 15' E$, to Eyrie Peak $N 57^{\circ} 57' E$, to Benlornond Peak $N 37^{\circ} 57' E$ and to a monument of stones on Greenock's Island $N 85^{\circ} 54' N$. The total length of the foregoing road is 924.40 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Northwestward through West Weber District.

11. Beginning in the center of the street leading from West Weber District to Ogden City, at the North East corner of Section Twenty Eight Township Six North of Range Six West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which the bearings are as follows: to Observatory Peak $S 76^{\circ} 19' E$, to Eyrie Peak $N 66^{\circ} 53' E$, to Benlornond Peak $N 30^{\circ} 45' E$, running from thence due North 38.54 chains, thence $N 4^{\circ} E$ 34.18 chains, thence $N 43^{\circ} N$ 6.02 chains, thence $N 17^{\circ} N$ 2.84 chains, near the residence of A. Greenwell in West Weber, thence $N 35^{\circ} N$ 7.17 chains, thence $S 88^{\circ} 30' N$ 52.53 chains, to a point near the West Weber school house, thence $N 2^{\circ} 50' E$ 39.99 chains, thence $S 75^{\circ} 22' N$ 7.79 chains, thence $N 87^{\circ} 14' N$ 55.18 chains, to the intersection of

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 on page 381-2 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Ogden City to Harper -

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the said street 3 chains due east from the northwest corner of Section 36 in Township 6 North of Range One West, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 62, the bearings from said monument being as follows: to Observatory Peak S. $78^{\circ}38'$ E. to Eyrie Peak N. $46^{\circ}09'$ E. to Benlomonad Peak N. $12^{\circ}49\frac{1}{2}'$ E. running from thence S. $42^{\circ}40'$ W. 108.85 chains parallel to and $85\frac{1}{2}$ feet distant on the west side from the Utah Central R.R. track to the south line of section 36 Township 6 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence due west 19.53 chains to the southwest corner

of Section No. 35 in the above named Township and Range thence south 40 chains, thence west 70.04 chains, thence S. $28^{\circ}53\frac{1}{2}'$ W. 46.30 chains to a point 13 chains west from the southeast corner of Section 4, in Township 5, North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence west 29 chains, thence south 20 chains, thence west 20.08 chains, thence south 20.04 chains, thence west 19.48 chains, thence south 40.60 chains to the southeast corner of Section 8, Township 5 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian from which the bearings are as follows: to Observatory Peak N. $89^{\circ}40'$ E., to Eyrie Peak N. $49^{\circ}22'$ E. and to Benlomonad Peak N. $25^{\circ}56'$ E., thence S. $89^{\circ}45'$ W. 39.50 chains to the center of a road leading northward to West Weber ^{District}, being 150 of one chain due east from the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of Section 8 in Township 5 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian thence S. $0^{\circ}07'$ W. 67.80 chains to the intersection of a road four rods wide leading eastward from Harper District,

The bearings from said points are as follows: — to
 Observatory Peak N. $76^{\circ}50\frac{1}{2}'$ E., to Eyrie Peak N. $47^{\circ}51'$
 E., to Benlomon's Peak N. $26^{\circ}15'$ E. thence due west 40.40
 chains to the intersection of the center of a street
 running north from the eastern part of Hooper District,
 thence continuing west 82.08 chains to the inter-
 section of the center of the street leading north and
 south on the east side of Plat "A" Hooper City Survey;
 the bearings from said point to Observatory Peak being
 N. $78^{\circ}25'$ E. from this point westward for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile
 said road is six rods in width, thence due west 82.10
 chains to the center of the street running north and
 south near the schoolhouse in the western part of

Hooper District, from which point the bearings
 to Observatory Peak is N. $79^{\circ}16'$ E and to Eyrie
 Peak N. $54^{\circ}57'$ E, thence continuing west 81.90
 chains to the intersection of the center of a street
 running north and south in the western
 part of Hooper near the Eastern shore of the Great
 Salt Lake, the bearings from said point being
 as follows: to Observatory Peak N. 80° E., to
 Benlomon's Peak N. 37° E. thence continuing
 due west 28.70 chains to the Eastern shore of
 the Great Salt Lake, from which point the bearings
 were taken as follows: — to Observatory Peak N.
 $80^{\circ}15'$ E. to Eyrie Peak, N. $57^{\circ}57'$ E., to Ben-
 lomon's Peak N. $37^{\circ}57'$ E. and to a monument of
 stone on Fremont's Island N. $85^{\circ}54'$ E. The
 total length of the foregoing road is 924.40 chains.
