the center of a street leading Southward through the Western part of West Weber to Hooper District, the bearings from said point of intersection being as follows; to Observatory Peak S. $70^{\circ} 40\frac{1}{2}'$ E. to Eyrie Peak N. $79^{\circ} 43'$ E. The length of the foregoing road is 244.24 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Northward from Hooper District through West Weber, and to the Weber River.

117. Beginning at a point in the center of the street leading from Hooper District to Ogden City $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain due East from the South West corner of the South East Quarter of Section No Eight, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which point the following bearings were taken; to Observatory Peak N. $81^{\circ} 04\frac{1}{2}'$ E.; to Eyrie Peak N. $50^{\circ} 49'$ E.; to Benlomaud Peak N. $27^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}'$ E.; running from thence North 14.49 chains, to the intersection of the center of a street leading Westward, thence continuing North 65.88 chains, to the intersection of a street leading East and West, and on the North line of the above named Section No. Eight, the bearings from the point of intersection are as follows to Observatory Peak N. $86^{\circ} 18\frac{1}{2}'$ E.; to Eyrie Peak N. $55^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}'$ E.; and to Benlomaud Peak N. $29^{\circ} 42'$ E.; thence due North 161.09 chains to Monument No. 63, situated at the intersection of a street leading East to the U. S. R. R. near the U. S. Observatory at Ogden City, thence continuing due North in the center of the street 80.19 chains, to the center of a street leading Eastward to Ogden City, and being $\frac{25}{100}$ of one chain due East from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of Section No Twenty Nine, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence continuing North 122.91 chains, to the intersection of a road leading Southeastward through West Weber District, thence continuing North 102.48 chains to a point near the Weber River, from which the following bearings were taken; to Observatory Peak S. $65^{\circ} 01'$ E. to Eyrie Peak N. $87^{\circ} 50\frac{1}{2}'$ E. & to Benlomaud Peak N. $48^{\circ} 06\frac{1}{2}'$ E. The length of the foregoing road is 547.04 chains.

48. Description of a County Road partly four and partly six rods wide, leading from a point on the Southern boundary line of Weber County, in Hooper District, Northward and Eastward through the Northern part of Hooper, and intersecting the road from

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Ogden City to Hooper, near the Homeville schoolhouse.

Beginning at a point on the Southern boundary line of Weber County, in the center of the street leading North and South on the East side of Plat "A," Hooper City Survey from which the following bearings were taken: to the South West corner of the North West Quarter of Section Nineteen Township Five North of Range Two West of Salt Lake Meridian N. 30° 00' E. 44.75 chains; to Observatory Peak N. 75° 19' E. to Eyrice Peak N. 119° 58' E. to Benlmonds Peak N. 29° 53½' E. running from thence North in the center of a street four rods in width 15.81 chains to the center of a street leading Eastward near the residence of Henry Manning in Hooper District from which point the following bearings were taken: to Observatory Peak N. 76° 10' E. to Eyrice Peak N. 50° 37½' E. to Benlmonds Peak N. 30° 14½' E. and being near the school house in the Eastern part of Hooper District, continuing thence North 41.34 chains to the intersection of the street leading Eastward to Ogden City; and one rod East of the center of the street six rods in width leading South on the East side of Plat "A," Hooper City Survey, thence North 82.40 chains in the center of a street four rods in width, and to the intersection of a road leading Eastward to the Eastern part of Hooper District, thence continuing North 41.29 chains, thence East 61.41 chains, thence North 3.96 chains, thence East 20.58 chains, thence North 20.51 chains, and to the North West corner of Section Eight, Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence N. 87° 45' E. on the North line of said section, 40.68 chains, to the center of the street leading North from Hooper to West Weber, thence continuing N. 87° 45' E. 79.06 chains, to the intersection of the center of the road leading from Ogden to Hooper District, and being the South East corner of the South West Quarter of Section Four, Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian. The bearing to the chimney on the Homeville school-house being N. 85° 24' E. The length of the foregoing road is 407.04 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Westward through the Northern part of Hooper District.

Beginning at a point in the center of the street leading Northward from Hooper to West Weber District being 11.49 chains North and $\frac{50}{100}$ of one chain East from the South West corner of the South East Quarter of Section No. Eight, Township Five North of Range

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book) on page 383-4 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

48. From the southern boundary line of Weber County in Hooper, to Kanawville School house.

Beginning at a point on the southern boundary line of Weber County in the center of the street leading north and south on the east side of Plat "A" Hooper City Survey from which the following bearings were taken, ~~to~~ the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of Section 19 Township 5 North of Range 2 West Salt Lake Meridian, N. 30° 04' E. 475 chains, to Observatory Peak N. 75° 19' E. to Eyriv Peak N. 49° 58' E. to Benlomon Peak N. 29° 53½' E. running from thence north in the center of a street four rods in width 15.81 chains to the center of a street leading eastward near the residence of Henry

Manning in Hooper, from which point the following bearings were taken: to Observatory Peak N. 76° 10' E. to Eyriv Peak N. 50° 37½' E. to Benlomon Peak N. 30° 14½' E. and being near the school-house in the eastern part of Hooper District continuing thence North 41.34 chains to the intersection of the street, leading Eastward to Ogden City; and one rod east of the center of the street six rods wide leading south on the east side of Plat "A" Hooper City Survey, thence North 82.40 chains in the center of a street four rods ⁱⁿ width and to the intersection of a road leading eastward to the eastern part of Hooper District, thence continuing North 41.29 chains, thence east 61.41 chains, thence North 3.96 chains, thence east 20.58 chains, thence North 20.51 chains, and to the Northwest Corner of Section 8, ⁱⁿ Township 5 North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, thence N. 89° 45' E. ^{on} the north line of said section 40.68 chains, to the center of the street leading north from Hooper to West Weber, thence continuing N. 89° 45' E. 79.06 chains, to the intersection of the center of the road leading from Ogden to Hooper District and being the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of Section 4, in Township 5, North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian. The bearing to the chimney of the Kanawville School ^{house} being N. 85° 24' E. The length of the foregoing road being 407.04 chains.
