

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

1895.

March 3.

Two West of Salt Lake Meridian, from which the following bearings were taken: to Observatory Peak N. 82° E.; to Egypt's Peak N. 51° 41½' E.; to Benlornond Peak N. 28° 01' E.; running from thence West 40.77 chains to the center of a street running North & South in the Eastern part of Hooper District; thence continuing West 81.96 chains to the intersection of the center of a street running North and South in the central part of Hooper District; the bearings from this point to Observatory Peak is N. 82° 57½' E. continuing thence West 82.10 chains to the center of a street running North and South near the school house in the Western part of Hooper, thence continuing West 81.90 chains to the center of a street running North and South through the Western part of Hooper and near the Great Salt Lake. This road also runs West to the shore of said Lake. The length of the foregoing road up to the point of intersection is 286.73 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Westward through the Southern part of Hooper City to the Great Salt Lake.

50. Beginning at a point in the center of the street leading from Ogden City to Hooper, being 67.80 chains S. 0° 07' N. from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of Section No. Seventeen, Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, and on the West line of said quarter section, running from thence due South 41.34 chains, thence West 39.96 chains to the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward in the Eastern part of Hooper, thence continuing West 82.00 chains to the intersection of the center of the street leading Northward through the central part of Hooper, thence West 41.10 chains, in a street six rods in width, one rod South from the center thereof, thence continuing West 41.10 chains in the center of a street four rods in width, and to the intersection of the center of a street running North near the school house of the Western part of Hooper District, thence continuing West 82.20 chains to the intersection of the center of a road leading North in the extreme Western part of Hooper, thence West 23.09 chains to the Eastern shore of the Great Salt Lake, from which point the following bearings were taken: to Observatory Peak N. 78° 17' E. to Egypt's Peak N. 56° 11' E. to Benlornond Peak N. 36° 46' E. to a monument of stones on Fremont's Island N. 81° 42' N. The total length of the foregoing road is 356.79 chains.

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book on page 385 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

50. From Hooper to Great Salt Lake: -

Beginning at a point in the center of the street leading from Ogden City to Hooper, being 67.80 chains $S 0^{\circ} 07' N$ E. from the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of Section 17, Township 5 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, and on the west line of said Quarter Section, running from thence due south 41.34 chains, thence west 39.96 chains, to the intersection of the center of a street leading northward in the eastern part of Hooper, thence continuing west 82 chains to the intersection of the center of the street leading northward through the central part of Hooper, thence West 41.10 chains, in a street six rods in width, one rod south from the center thereof, thence continuing West 41.10 chains, in the center of

a street four rods in width, and to the intersection of the center of a street running north near the school-house of the western part of Hooper District, thence continuing ^{West} 82.20 chains to the intersection of the center of a road leading north in the extreme western part of Hooper, thence west 2309 chains to the eastern shore of the Great Salt Lake from which point the following bearings were taken: to Observatory Peak $N. 78^{\circ} 17' E.$ to Eyrice Peak $N. 56^{\circ} 11' E.$ to Benlomon Peak $N. 36^{\circ} 46' E.$ and to a Monument of Stones on Fremont's Island $N. 81^{\circ} 42' N.$ The total length of the above road is 350.79 chains.
