

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Eastward from Hooper to the intersection of the main road leading Southward from Ogden City to the South boundary line of Weber County.

51. Beginning at a point in the center of the road leading from Ogden City to Hooper District, being $\frac{200}{100}$ of one chain East and 67.80 chains $N. 0^{\circ} 01' N.$ from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of Section No. Seventeen, Township Five North of Range Two West of Salt Lake Meridian, from which point the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak $N. 76^{\circ} 50\frac{1}{2}' E.$ to Eyrice Peak $N. 47^{\circ} 51' E.$ and to Benlornond Peak $N. 26^{\circ} 15' E.$, running from thence due East 120.00 chains to the intersection of the center of a road running North on the East line of Section Sixteen of the above named Township and Range, thence continuing East 74.56 chains to the center of the D & R. G. R. R. main line, bearing $N. 3^{\circ} 09' N.$, thence continuing East 20.66 chains to the center of the U. C. R. R. main line, bearing $N. 16^{\circ} 47' N.$, thence East 67.64 chains to the intersection of the center of the main road eight rods in width leading Southward from Ogden City to the South boundary line of Weber County, said point being known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 58, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak $N. 70^{\circ} 54\frac{1}{2}' E.$ to Eyrice Peak $N. 33^{\circ} 31\frac{1}{2}' E.$ and to Benlornond Peak $N. 13^{\circ} 15' E.$ The total length of the foregoing road is 282.86 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading from the Eastern part of Hooper District, at Hooper Springs Eastward toward Riverdale.

52. Beginning at a point in the center of the road from Ogden City to Hooper District, being at the South East corner of Section Eight, Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak $N. 80^{\circ} 40' E.$ to Eyrice Peak $N. 49^{\circ} 22' E.$ to Benlornond Peak $N. 25^{\circ} 56' E.$, running from thence East on the North line of Section Sixteen, in the above Township and Range, to the North East corner of said Section 80.00 chains and to the center of a road leading Southward on the East line of said section, thence East on the North line of Section Fifteen of the above named Township and Range 80.00 chains, to the North West corner of Section Fourteen, Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian. The total length of the above road is 160.00 chains more or less.

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 386 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From eastern part of Hooper toward Riverside: -

Beginning at a point in the center of a road from Ogden City to Hooper District, being at the southeast corner of Section 8, Township 5 North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak N. 10° 40' E., to Eerie Peak N. 49° 22' E., to Benlomon Peak N. 25° 36', running from thence east on the North Line of Section 16 in the above Township and Range, to the northeast corner of Section 8, 80 chains and to the center of a road leading southward on the east line of said section, thence east on the north line of Section 15, of the above named Township and Range, 80 chains to the northwest

corner of Section 14, Township 5 North of Range Two West Salt Lake Meridian. The total length of the above road is 160 chains more or less.
