March 3.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading South on the East line of sections sixteen and twenty three in Township Five North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian.

53. Beginning at the North East corner of Section No. sixteen, Township Five North, of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, and running from thence South 129.10 chains, to the South line of Weber County. The length of the foregoing road being 129.10 chains.

Description of a County Road partly six rods and partly four rods wide leading from Huntsville District Eastward to the mouth of "South Fork Cañon".

54. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street in Huntsville, $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain North and $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain East from the North East corner of Block "Thirteen Plat A" Huntsville Survey, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $54^{\circ} 46'$ N. to Boulton Peak N. $54^{\circ} 49'$ N. to center of flagstaff on Public Square S. $43^{\circ} 34'$ N. and to spire on Huntsville meeting-house N. $83^{\circ} 54\frac{1}{2}'$ N., being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 97, running from thence N. $88^{\circ} 35'$ E. 18.80 chains in the center of a street six rods in width, thence due North 8.72 chains in the center of a street six rods in width, thence S. $88^{\circ} 45'$ E. 7.89 chains in the center of a street four rods in width, and to "Monument No. 99, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to "Middle Fork Cañon," thence continuing S. $88^{\circ} 45'$ E. 135.26 chains in the center of a street four rods in width, thence S. $83^{\circ} 45'$ E. 34.04 chains, and to a point N. $0^{\circ} 37\frac{1}{2}'$ N. 23.42 chains from the South East corner of the North East Quarter of Section sixteen, Township Six North of Range Two East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence continuing S. $83^{\circ} 45'$ E. 3.00 chains, thence due East 40.00 chains, to a point 2.74 chains East and 17.23 chains South from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of Section fifteen, of the above Township and Range, thence East 29.72 chains, thence N. $65^{\circ} 6'$ E. 40.83 chains to a point in the mouth of "South Fork Cañon" near the residence of Enastus Bingham, from which the bearing to Observatory Peak was S. $65^{\circ} 32'$ N. and to the North East corner of Bingham's log-house S. $3^{\circ} 10'$ N. 4.19 chains.

The length of the foregoing road is 318.26 chains.

Minutes of the meeting of March 7th, read and approved.

A petition signed by Peter C. Changyants and 31 other residents, who tax payers of Huntsville asking that the roads east of Huntsville through Section 15 be changed from its present location; and also upon the 80 rods line from the North side of said section, new roads and on motion of Selection J. Fry, was referred to Selection Shurtliff with power to act.

A communication from Hebronville Land grant in which she states that her home assessed to Andrew H. Linnquist, though some acreage has been sold for taxes though the taxes had been remitted by the Board of Equalization, was read and referred to the Clerk for investigation.

In accordance with a recommendation of the County Surveyor Selection Shurtliff recommended that owing to an error in the original survey that portion of the Riverside County Road lying between County Monument #18 situated in the center of said road at its intersection with the center line of Washington Avenue in Ogden City and the Olden River bridge be abandoned and relocated so as to conform as near as possible to existing lines. On motion of Selection Fry, it was ordered that the recommendation

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 387 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

54. From Huntsville to mouth of South Fork.

Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street in Huntsville .75 of one chain north and .75 of one chain east from the northeast corner of Block 13, Plat "A", Huntsville Survey, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $54^{\circ}46'$ W., to Benlmond Peak N. $54^{\circ}49'$ W., to Center of Flagstaff on Public Square S. $43^{\circ}34'$ W., and to the spire on the Huntsville Meeting House N. $83^{\circ}54\frac{1}{2}'$ W., being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 97, running from thence N. $88^{\circ}35'$ E. 18.80 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence due north 8.72 chains in the center of a street six rods in width, thence S. $88^{\circ}45'$ E. 7.89 chains in the center of a street four rods in width and to Monument No. 99, situated at the intersection of the center of a street leading Northward to Middle Fork Canyon, thence continuing S. $88^{\circ}45'$ E. 135.76 chains, in the center of a street four rods in width, thence S. $83^{\circ}45'$ E. 34.04 chains, and to a point N. $0^{\circ}39\frac{1}{2}'$ W. 23.42 chains from the southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 6, North of Range Two East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence continuing S. $83^{\circ}45'$ E. 3 chains, thence due east 40 chains, to a point 2.74 chains east and 17.23 chains south from the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15, of the above Township and Range, thence east 29.72 chains, thence 65° E. 40.83 chains, to a point in the mouth of South Fork Canyon, near the home of Erastus Bingham, from which the bearing to Observatory Peak was S. $65^{\circ}32'$ W. and to the northeast corner of Bingham's log house S. $31^{\circ}0'$ W. 4.19 chains. Length of this road is 318.76 chains.

A petition signed by Peter Wanggaard and
3, other citizens of Huntsville, asking that the road
east of Huntsville through Section 15 be
changed from its present location; and over
upon the S. rd. line from the north side of
said Section, was read and on recom-
mendation of committee, the road was ordered
changed, provided that the petitioners will
put the new road in good condition, as
the present road is now.
