Description of a County Road six rods wide leading from
Huntsville to Eden.

57. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street in Huntsville $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain North and $\frac{75}{100}$ of one chain East from the North East corner of Block Thirteen, Plat "A," Huntsville Survey, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 97, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $54^{\circ} 46'$ N. to Benlorned Peak N. $51^{\circ} 49'$ N. and to the spire on the Huntsville meeting-house N. $83^{\circ} 54 \frac{1}{2}'$ N. running from thence S. $88^{\circ} 35'$ N. 66.61 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence N. $1^{\circ} 18'$ N. 9.62 chains, thence S. $88^{\circ} 11 \frac{1}{2}'$ N. 21.57 chains, to Monument No. 96, at the intersection of a road leading Southwestward to the mountains, thence N. $37^{\circ} 45'$ N. 8.98 chains, thence N. $60^{\circ} 30'$ N. 12.37 chains, thence N. $86^{\circ} 30'$ N. 10.54 chains, thence N. $60^{\circ} 05'$ N. 17.45 chains, thence N. $71^{\circ} 41'$ N. 7.55 chains, thence N. $53'$ N. 2.00 chains, thence N. $42^{\circ} 30'$ N. 15.00 chains, thence due West 11.00 chains, to Monument No. 91, situated in the center of the street leading from Ogden City to Ogden Valley, running from thence N. $0^{\circ} 15'$ E. 134.54 chains, to a point $\frac{100}{100}$ of one chain West from the South East corner of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty Five, Township Seven North, of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, and in the center of the road running Eastward to "Middle Fork Cañon", the bearing to Observatory Peak is S. $31^{\circ} 48'$ N. The length of the foregoing road is 317.23 chains up to this point.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Southwestward from
the West end of Huntsville.

58. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading from Huntsville to Eden, 8.59 chains West and 10.95 chains South from the North East corner of the North West Quarter of Section Thirteen, Township Six North, of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 96, from which the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $48^{\circ} 23 \frac{1}{2}'$ N. to Benlorned Peak N. $52^{\circ} 03'$ N. and to the spire on the Huntsville meeting-house S. $66^{\circ} 31'$ E. running

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from thence S. $1^{\circ} 15' N.$ 11.53 chains, thence S. $68^{\circ} 45' N.$ 33.85 chains, thence S. $0^{\circ} 45' N.$ 40.00 chains, from which point the following observations were made: to Observatory Peak S. $51^{\circ} 43' N.$ to Benlomonad Peak N. $47^{\circ} 40' N.$ and to the spire on the Huntsville meeting house N. $63^{\circ} 05' E.$ The length of the foregoing road is 85.38 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Eastward from Eden to "Middle Fork Cañon."

59. Beginning at a point in the center of the road from Huntsville to Eden, being $\frac{100}{100}$ of one chain West from the South East corner of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty Five, Township Seven North of Range One East of Salt Lake Meridian, from which point the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $31^{\circ} 48' N.$ to Benlomonad Peak N. $58^{\circ} 43\frac{1}{2}' N.$ running from thence S. $89^{\circ} 32' E.$ 185.25 chains, on the North line of Township Six, and to a monument of stones in the mouth of "Middle Fork Cañon," from which point the bearing to Observatory Peak is S. $44^{\circ} 31' N.$

Description of a County Road partly six rods wide leading through Eden and Northwestwards to the Eastern mouth of Ogden Hole Cañon.

60. Beginning at a point in the center of the road leading from Huntsville to Eden, $\frac{100}{100}$ of one chain West from the South East corner of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty Five, Township Seven North of Range One East, from which point the following bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak S. $31^{\circ} 48' N.$ to Benlomonad Peak N. $58^{\circ} 43\frac{1}{2}' N.$ to the spire on the Huntsville meeting house S. $40^{\circ} 04' E.$ running from thence N. $89^{\circ} 45' N.$ 18.00 chains, in the center of a road six rods in width, thence N. $1^{\circ} 47' E.$ 30.55 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence N. $88^{\circ} 13' N.$ 21.12 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence N. $1^{\circ} 47' E.$ 10.50 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence N. $88^{\circ} 13' N.$ 11.29 chains, in the center of a street six rods in width, thence N. $34^{\circ} 15' N.$ 12.00 chains, in the center of a street four rods in width, thence S. $80^{\circ} 45' N.$ 5.00 chains, in the center of a street four rods in width, said road also continues to be four rods in width to its termination, thence N. $1^{\circ} 30' N.$ 7.26 chains, thence N. $89^{\circ} N.$ 16.11 chains, thence N. $58^{\circ} 30' N.$ 2.63 chains, to Monument No. 100, at the intersection of the center of a road leading Northwards to "Half Creek Cañon," thence continuing N. $58^{\circ} 30' N.$ 13.37 chains, thence N. $42^{\circ} 45' N.$ 17.89 chains, thence N. $42^{\circ} N.$

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 5th
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 C on page 389-90 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Southwestward from the west end of Huntsville:
 Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone
 situated in the center of the street, leading from
 Huntsville to Eden, 8.59 chains west, and 10.95 chains
 south from the northeast corner of the northwest quarter
 of Section 13, Township 6 North of Range One East, Salt
 Lake Meridian, being known and designated as Weber
 County Survey Monument No. 96, from which the following
 bearings were observed: to Observatory Peak $S. 48^{\circ} 23' \frac{1}{2} W.$ to
 Benesmond Peak $N. 57^{\circ} 0' W.$ and to the spire on the Hun-
 tsville Meeting-house $S. 66^{\circ} 31' E.$ running from thence $S. 1^{\circ} 15' W.$
 11.53 chains, thence $S. 68^{\circ} 45' W.$ 33.85 chains, thence
 $S. 0^{\circ} 45' W.$ 40 chains from which point the following
 observations were made: — to Observatory Peak,
 $S. 51^{\circ} 43' W.$, to Benesmond Peak $N. 47^{\circ} 40' W.$ and
 to the spire on the Huntsville Meeting house, $N. 63^{\circ} 05' E.$
 The length of the foregoing road is 85.38
 chains.
