25.31 chains, thence $N. 50^{\circ} 15' N.$ 11.56 chains, thence $N. 73^{\circ} N.$ 11.73 chains to Monument No. 101, situated at the intersection of the center of a road leading Northward on the East bank of "North Fork Creek," thence continuing $N. 73^{\circ} 00' N.$ 9.15 chains, thence $N. 82^{\circ} 45' N.$ 14.66 chains, crossing the channel of "North Fork," thence $N. 56^{\circ} 44' N.$ 5.34 chains, thence $N. 59^{\circ} N.$ 13.99 chains, thence $N. 45^{\circ} N.$ 10.71 chains, thence $N. 62^{\circ} N.$ 17.10 chains, thence $S. 80^{\circ} N.$ 13.73 chains, thence $N. 53^{\circ} 30' N.$ 35.88 chains, to Monument No. 102, at the intersection of the center of a road leading Northward through "Liberty" District, thence continuing $N. 83^{\circ} 30' N.$ 43.36 chains, thence $S. 85^{\circ} 20' N.$ 4.76 chains, thence $S. 63^{\circ} 30' N.$ 12.84 chains, to a point near the Eastern mouth of "Ogden Hole Cañon," the bearing to Wolf Creek Peak being $N. 41^{\circ} 40' E.$ The total length of the foregoing road is 387.76 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide, leading from Eden Northward to Wolf Creek Cañon, in Ogden Valley.

61. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of a street leading from Eden Northwestward to Ogden Hole Cañon, near the residence of John Carver, in the Northern part of Eden, being known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 100, the bearing to the spire on the Huntsville meeting-house being $S. 43^{\circ} 41' E.$ Magnetic Azimuth $N. 17^{\circ} E.$, running from thence due North 57.09 chains, thence $N. 18^{\circ} 01' N.$ 13.00 chains, thence $N. 33^{\circ} 40' N.$ 11.74 chains, thence $N. 26^{\circ} 30' N.$ 6.98 chains, thence $N. 41^{\circ} N.$ 10.59 chains, thence $N. 66^{\circ} 20' N.$ 8.21 chains, thence $N. 18^{\circ} 45' N.$ 10.99 chains, thence $N. 21^{\circ} E.$ 17.25 chains, thence $N. 1^{\circ} 45' E.$ 17.88 chains, to a point in the mouth of "Wolf Creek Cañon" from which point the bearings are as follows: to Observatory Peak $S. 17^{\circ} N.$ to Benlomonet Peak $N. 70^{\circ} 31' N.$ and to Cottonwood Peak $S. 31^{\circ} 53\frac{1}{2}' E.$ The length of the foregoing road is 146.73 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Northward through "Liberty" District in the North end of Ogden Valley.

62. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Northward from Eden, being 21.97 chains South and 1.70 chains West from the North East corner of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty Nine.

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Township Seven North of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 102, running from thence $N. 3^{\circ} E. 22.00$ chains to the North line of the above named Section Twenty Nine, thence $N. 0^{\circ} 32' E. 60.00$ chains to a point 20.66 chains South from the North East corner of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty - of the above Township and Range, and to the intersection of a road leading Southeastward to Eden, thence due West 20.00 chains, thence North 41.95 chains, thence $N. 16^{\circ} 30' W. 23.25$ chains, thence $N. 25^{\circ} 40' W. 30.63$ chains, thence due North 7.76 chains to a point $N. 0^{\circ} 01' W. 01$ chain West and 166 chains South from the North East corner of Section Eighteen, Township Seven North of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence $N. 54^{\circ} W. 8.25$ chains, thence $N. 48^{\circ} 20' W. 8.55$ chains, thence $N. 37^{\circ} W. 5.18$ chains, thence $N. 42^{\circ} W. 3.23$ chains, to a point near the North Fork of Ogden River from which the following bearings were observed: to Round Peak $N. 81^{\circ} 56' W.$ and to "Cottonwood Peak" $S. 35^{\circ} 33' E.$, thence $N. 35^{\circ} 30' E. 5.37$ chains, crossing the channel of "North Fork" to its Eastern bank. The length of the foregoing road is 236.37 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Southward and Eastward from Liberty District, in the North end of Ogden Valley.

63. Beginning at a point in the center of said road 20.66 chains South from the North East corner of the North West Quarter of Section Twenty, Township Seven North of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, the bearing to the spire on the Huntsville meeting-house, $S. 44^{\circ} 12' E.$ running from thence due East 9.77 chains, thence $S. 49^{\circ} E. 6.21$ chains, thence $N. 81^{\circ} E. 12.18$ chains, thence $N. 80^{\circ} 52' E. 13.66$ chains, thence East 20.44 chains crossing "North Fork" to its Eastern side, thence $S. 18^{\circ} E. 25.73$ chains, thence $S. 9^{\circ} E. 27.11$ chains, thence $S. 21^{\circ} W. 3.37$ chains, thence $S. 21^{\circ} E. 6.15$ chains, thence $S. 3^{\circ} 30' W. 4.08$ chains, thence $S. 16^{\circ} E. 5.35$ chains, thence $S. 37^{\circ} 30' E. 55.91$ chains, to Monument No. 101, situated at the intersection of the center of the road leading from Eden Northwestward to the Eastern mouth of Ogden Hole Cañon. Bearings are as follows: to the spire on the Huntsville meeting-house $S. 44^{\circ} 21' E.$ and to Cottonwood Peak $S. 35^{\circ} 37' E.$

The length of the foregoing road is 187.95 chains.

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 5th day of March A. D. 1881 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book 391-2 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

62. From Liberty to North end of Ogden Valley:-
 Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street leading Northwest from Eden, being 21.97 chains South and 1.70 chains West from the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 29, Township 7 North of Range One East Salt Lake Meridian, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 102; running from thence N. 3° E. 22 chains to the north line of the above named Section 29, thence N. 0° 34' E. 60 chains to a point 20.66 chains South from the northeast corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 20 of the above named Township and Range and to the intersection of a road lying Southeastward to Eden, thence due West 20 chains, thence North 41.95 chains, thence N. 16° 30' W. 23.75 chains, thence N. 25° 40' W. 30.63 chains, thence due North 7.96 chains to a point .07 of one chain West and 1.66 chains South from the Northeast corner of Section 18, Township 7 North of Range One East, Salt Lake Meridian, thence N. 54° W. 8.25 chains, thence N. 48° 20' W. 8.55 chains, thence N. 37° W. 5.18 chains, thence N. 47° W. 3.23 chains, to a point near the North Fork of Ogden River, from which the following bearings were observed: to Benesmond Peak N. 81° 56' W., to Cottonwood Peak S. 35° 33' E., thence N. 35° 30' E. 5.39 chains, crossing the channel of North Fork to its eastern bank. The length of the foregoing road is 236.37 chains.

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 26th
 day of May A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 on page 64 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

The petition signed by Electa Montgomery and 52 others was read praying that a County Road be opened running north 160 rods long, across Section 17, Township 7 North range 1 East. The petition was referred to Commissioner Smith, who made a visit to Liberty for the purpose of ascertaining the advisability of opening and locating a County Road as heretofore petitioned for; that he had investigated the matter thoroughly and believed that the location as petitioned for would be practicable, and he had therefore instructed the Road Supervisor of Liberty to commence the necessary work.
