

## Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

1885.

March 3.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Westward from a point near the wagon bridge across Four Mile Creek South from Plain City.

64. Beginning at a point in the center of the road from Slaterville to Plain City, 20.53 chains West and 6.90 chains North from the center of Section Four, Township Six North of Range Two West, Salt Lake Meridian, running from thence S. 70° 29' N. 20.65 chains, thence West 40.00 chains, to the West line of Section Five, in the above named Township and to the center of a street leading Northward to Plain City, thence continuing West 40.50 chains, thence South 15.00 chains, thence N. 89° N. 11.80 chains, thence South 46.00 chains, thence N. 86° 30' N. 108.00 chains, thence due South 106. chains. The length of the above road is 387.95 chains.

Description of a County Road partly six rods and partly four rods wide, from the Plain City Cemetery Westward and Southward to intersect the road leading Westward from "Four Mile Creek."

65. Beginning at a certain monument of sandstone situated in the center of the street six rods in width running Eastward through the Southern part of Plain City, being  $\frac{75}{100}$  of one chain South and  $\frac{50}{100}$  of one chain West from the South West corner of Lot 10, Plat "B," Plain City Survey, known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 37, from which the following observations were made: to Observatory Peak S. 59° 05 1/2' E. to Benlombard Peak N. 53° 27' E. and to Eyrie Peak S. 83° 41 1/2' E., running from thence N. 89° 17' N. 7.50 chains in the center of a street six rods in width and to the intersection of the center of a road leading North & West from Plain City, thence continuing N. 89° 17' N. 17.00 chains in the center of a road four rods in width, thence S. 3° N. 9.89 chains, in the center of a road four rods in width, thence due West 2.65 chains, to the South West corner of the South East Quarter of Section Thirty Two, Township Seven North of Range Two West of Salt Lake Meridian, thence South 40.00 chains to the intersection of the center of a road leading West from Slaterville. The length of the foregoing road is 77.04 chains.

Description of a County Road four rods wide leading Westward from Plain City.

66. Beginning in the center of the street leading Eastward through the Southern part of Plain City at a point  $\frac{75}{100}$  of one chain North and  $\frac{50}{100}$  of one chain West from the

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North West corner of Lot 71 Plat "B" Plain City Survey, running from thence N. 0° 27' E, 21.25 chains, in the center of said street, thence due West 22.73 chains, thence S. 78° 31' W 60.60 chains, thence due West 17.07 chains, to the West side of "Salt Creek, thence continuing West 4.287 chains, to a point 21.16 chains South from the North West corner of the South West Quarter of Section Thirty One, Township Seven North of Range Five West, Salt Lake Meridian, from which point said road also continues due West to the Great Salt Lake. The length of the foregoing road up to this point is 166.54 chains.

Description of a County Road six rods wide, known as Franklin Street, in Ogden City.

67. Beginning in the center of Eighth Street in Ogden City at a point  $\frac{75}{100}$  of one chain South and  $\frac{65}{100}$  of one chain West from the South West corner of Block Five, Plat "A" Ogden City Survey, running from thence N. 0° 25' E, in the center of Franklin Street 80.85 chains, to the center of First Street in Ogden City. The length of the foregoing road being 80.85 chains.

Description of a County Road six rods wide, leading from Salt Creek District to Little Mountain.

68. Beginning at the North East corner of Section Thirteen in Township Six North of Range Three West of Salt Lake Meridian, and running from thence West on the North line of Sections Thirteen, Fourteen and Fifteen in the above Township and Range 240.00 chains, to the North West corner of Section Fifteen thence due South 40.00 chains, thence West 200.00 chains, to the center of Section Eighteen and to the base of what is known as "Little Mountain", thence Northwesterly, following the old wagon road to the summit of said mountain. The length of the foregoing road to the base of said mountain is 480.00 chains.

Description of a County Road six rods wide, leading near the Little Mountain in Weber County, Utah.

69. Beginning at the center of Section Eighteen, Township Six North, of Range Three West, Salt Lake Meridian, and at the base of what is known as "The Little Mountain", running from thence Southeasterly and Southwesterly along the base of said mountain to the shore of the Great Salt Lake.

## Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 3rd  
 day of March A. D. 1885 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book,  
 on page 393-u &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Westward from Plain City:

66. Beginning in the center of the street leading eastward through the southern part of Plain City at a point .75 of one chain north and .50 of one chain west from the northwest corner of Lot 71, Plat B, Plain City Survey, running from thence N. 0° 29' E. 71.25 chains in the center of said street, thence due west 22.73 chains thence S. 78° 30' W. 60.60 chains, thence due west 19.09 chains, to the west side of Salt Creek, thence continuing west 42.87<sup>chains</sup> to a point 71.16 chains south from the Northwest corner of the southwest Quarter of Section 31, Township 7, North of Range 2 East, Salt Lake Meridian, from which point said road also continues due west to the Great Salt Lake. The length of the foregoing road up to this point is 166.54 chains.
