

August 7, 1889. 9:30 A.M. Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: A Full Board.

Prayer by the Clerk.

Minutes of yesterday were read and approved.

The verdict in the matter of the inquisition held upon the body of Jack Taylor was presented and ordered filed. A petition signed by William F. Smith and 30 others, was presented and read, asking that the County Road at the end of Fourth Street be changed.

The petition was referred to Selectman Child and Sheriff, with instructions to have said change surveyed and a description thereof reported to this Court.

After due consideration of the matter, on motion of Mr. Child, It was Ordered, that all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and 33 feet distant on each side of the following described line, to wit: Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, U.S. Survey, 17<sup>31</sup> chains South 89° 53' East from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of said Section 27, and running thence South 57° 40' East 3<sup>16.5</sup> chains, to the Eastern line of the West 1/2 of the North East Quarter of said Section 27.

On motion of Selectman Child.

It was Ordered that all that portion of land lying and being within lines drawn parallel with and 33 feet distant from the following described center line:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, U.S. Survey, 17<sup>31</sup> chains South 89° 53' East from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of said Section 27, and running thence

It was ordered that all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and <sup>33</sup> feet distant on each side of the following described line, be and the same is hereby discontinued and abandoned, to-wit:— Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of East Lake Meridian, U. S. Survey, 17.31 chains South  $89^{\circ} 53'$  East from the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Said Section 27, and running thence South  $57^{\circ} 40'$  East 3.165 chains to the eastern line of the West  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Northeast Quarter of Said Section 27.
