

August 7, 1889. 9:30 A. M. Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: A Full Board.

Prayer by the Clerk.

Minutes of yesterday were read and approved.

The verdict in the matter of the inquisition held upon the body of Jack Taylor was presented and ordered filed. A petition signed by William F. Smith and 30 others, was presented and read, asking that the County Road at the end of Fourth Street be changed.

The petition was referred to Selectman Child and Sheriff, with instructions to have said change surveyed and a description thereof reported to this Court.

After due consideration of the matter, on motion of Mr. Child, It was Ordered, that all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and 33 feet distant on each side of the following described line, to wit: Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, U. S. Survey, 17³¹ chains South 89° 53' East from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of said Section 27, and running thence South 57° 40' East 3^{16.5} chains, to the Eastern line of the West 1/2 of the North East Quarter of said Section 27.

On motion of Selectman Child.

It was Ordered, That all that portion of land lying and being within lines drawn parallel with and 33 feet distant from the following described center line:

Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, U. S. Survey, 17³¹ chains South 89° 53' East from the North West corner of the North East Quarter of said Section 27, and running thence

South 89° 53' East 2.69 chains, along the North line of said Section, thence South 16.38 chains, along the East line of the West 1/2 of the North East Quarter of said Section, and intersecting the center line of the County Road leading from West Weber District to Ogden, as heretofore adopted, by, and the same is hereby designated as, and declared to be a County Road, and public highway.

On motion of Mr. Childs

It was Ordered, That all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted, which is described as follows, by, and the same is hereby discontinued and abandoned, to wit: Beginning at a point 12 chains North and 50/100 of a chain East from the South West corner of Section 15, in Township 5 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, W. S. Survey, and running thence East 159 chains, along the center of said road or street, to a point 50/100 of a chain West of the East line of Section 14, in said Township and Range, and intersecting the West line of the County Road leading from Ogden City, through Paradise, to Salt Lake City.

On motion of Selectman Childs,

It was Ordered, That all that portion of the land described as follows, by, and the same is hereby designated as and set apart to be a County Road, or public highway to wit: Beginning at the South West corner of Section 15, Township 5 South of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, W. S. Survey, and running thence East 160 chains, along the center of street, and along the South line of said Sections 15 and 14, in said Township and Range, to the South East corner of said Section 14, and intersecting the center of the main County Road leading from Ogden City, through Paradise, to Salt Lake City.

The following claims were presented, read, allowed and ordered paid out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 7th
 day of August A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 G. on page 127 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

It was ordered that all that portion of land lying and being within lines drawn parallel with and 33 feet distant from the following described center lines: Beginning at a point on the North line of Section 27, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of Salt Lake Meridian, M. B. Survey, 17.31 chains South $89^{\circ}53'$ East from the northeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 27, and running thence South $89^{\circ}53'$ East 2.69 chains, along the north line of said section, thence south 1.638 chains, along the east line of the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast Quarter of said Section and intersecting the center line of the County Road leading from West Weber District to Ogden as heretofore adopted, be and the same is hereby designated as and declared to be a County Road and public highway.
