

August 1, 1889. South 89° 53' East 2.69 chains, along the North line of said Section thence South 1<sup>6</sup>/<sub>38</sub> chains, along the East line of the West 1/2 of the North-East Quarter of said Section, and intersecting the center line of the County Road leading from West Hill District to Ogden, as heretofore adopted, be, and the same is hereby designated as, and declared to be a County Road, and public highway.

On motion of Mr. Childs

It was Ordered, That all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted, which is described as follows, be, and the same is hereby discontinued and abandoned, to wit: Beginning at a point 12 chains North and 5/100 of a chain East from the South West corner of Section 15, in Township 5 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, W. S. Survey, and running thence East 159 chains, along the center of said road or street, to a point 5/100 of a chain West of the East line of Section 14, in said Township and Range, and intersecting the West line of the County Road leading from Ogden City, through Rivendale, to Salt Lake City.

On motion of Selectman Childs

It was Ordered, That all that portion of the land described as follows, be, and the same is hereby designated as and set apart to be a County Road, or public highway to wit: Beginning at the South West corner of Section 15, Township 5 South of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, W. S. Survey, and running thence East 160 chains, along the center of street, and along the South line of said Section 15 and 14, in said Township and Range, to the South East corner of said Section 14, and intersecting the center of the main County Road leading from Ogden City, through Rivendale, to Salt Lake City. The following claims were presented, read, allowed and ordered paid out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise

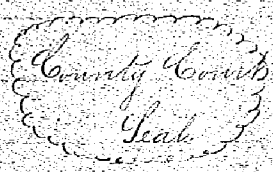
## Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 7<sup>th</sup>  
 day of August A. D. 1889 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
 E on page 178 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

It was ordered that all that portion of the County Road heretofore surveyed and adopted, which is described as follows; be and the same is hereby discontinued and abandoned, to-wit: Beginning at a point 12 chains North and .50 of one chain east from the Southwest Corner of Section 15, in Township 5 North of Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, U. S. Survey, and running thence east. 1.59 chains, along the center of said road or street to a point .50 of a chain west of the east line of Section 14, in said Township and Range, and intersecting the west line of the County Road leading from Ogden City, through Riverdale to Salt Lake City.

Carl Parich of Centerville, Davis County, Utah, appeared before the Court and asked that the road in Weber Canyon near Duke Gate, known as the Old Bend, be repaired by this County.

The matter was referred to Selectman Shurtliff & Child for investigation and consideration.

Representation was made to the Court that a road running through Kentville cuts off a piece of land belonging to Marinus Jensen of Hugo, C. Christensen. Said road was asked to be straightened and a deed made from Weber County to the parties owning said land.

The matter was referred to Selectman Shurtliff for investigation.

Selectman Child reported that Selectman Shurtliff of himself went out along the line of road from Ogden to Hooper City. The location of the road which was asked to be closed by Mr. Ritter was closely examined, and the Committee recommended that said road be closed, and that a road running due East and West along the Section line until it intersects the road which is now surveyed running West through the School Section.

The report was accepted, the recommendation adopted, and the Committee was instructed to have said road surveyed and a description thereof reported to this Court, so that it may be declared to be a County Road.
