

RECORD OF THE COUNTY COURT OF WEBER COUNTY, UTAH TERRITORY.

August 27, 1889.

In at the Court met pursuant to adjournment.

Present: Mr. Full Board.

Prayer by Mr. Wallace.

Minutes of the 21st inst. were read and approved.

Mr. Shurtliff, in behalf of the Committee, reported that Judge Cross and himself had inspected the road which Joel Terry and others complained had been closed up by David Jenkins, and after carefully investigating the matter were of the opinion that the road is a community road, and therefore recommended that the prayer of said petitioners be denied.

The report was accepted, the recommendation adopted, and the prayer of said petitioners was denied, as recommended.

A description of a section of County Road known as 4th Street West of Ogden City, was presented by George Jenkins, and after due consideration,

It was decided, That all that part of the County Road lying from Ogden City Westward and South Westward to Hope City, previously located and recorded, lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and 32 feet distant on each side of the following described land, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 5th chains North 72° 21' West of 2nd chain South 80° 27' West from Weber County, ^{Survey} Monument No 61, running thence South 80° 27' West 3rd chains, thence North 72° 21' West 9th chains, thence West 11th chains, thence South 66° 49' West 10th chains, thence South 80° West 4th chains, to the intersection of the center line of the street known as 4th Street, by and the same is hereby abandoned as a County Road. Also,

Decided That all that portion of land situated lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and 49th feet on each side of the following described land, to-wit: the same is hereby designated as and set apart to be a County Road, to-wit: Beginning at a point 5th chains North 72° 21' West from

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 27th day of August A. D. 1889 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book 6 on page 163-4 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Resolved that ~~see~~ that portion of land situate, lying and being within lines drawn parallel to and 49.5 feet on each side of the following described land, be and the same is hereby designated as and set apart to be a County Road to-wit: Beginning at a point 5.47 chains North $72^{\circ}21'$ West from Weber County Survey Monument No. 61, running thence South $80^{\circ}37'$ West, 2.509 chains, thence South 5.403 chains, thence North $89^{\circ}09'$ West 37.014 chains to the intersection of the center of the County Road previously located, leading southwestward to Hooper City.
