On motion of Selections Amos it was ordered that a Four Rods Road, beginning at the High Water and State side Bridge on the North side of the High Water River, and running thence North to the North line of John Edwin Evans, thence East thence East to a line running between Edwin and Fay's to the same running North on East side of Fay's Farm, thence North following said two rods line to the road running East and West along North line of Fay's (The County to pay Mr. Edwin \$100.00 providing Mr. Edwin puts up all fences adjoining his own property) be, and the same is hereby established as a County Road. The County agrees to pay Mr. Edwin \$100.00 damages and he to put up his own fences. Selections Shurtliff and Amos do not.

## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 14th  
 day of May A. D. 1891 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
27 on page 78 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

It was ordered that a Four<sup>rod</sup> Road, beginning at the West Shebu and ~~Paterville~~ Bridge on the North side of the Shebu river and running thence north to the north line of Jno. Ekins Farm, thence east to a line running between Ekin's and Fay's, to the road running north on the east side of Fay's farm, thence north following said two rod line to the road running east and west, along north line of Fay's ls and the same is hereby declared a County Road.



## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 24th day of April, A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book No. 160 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

In a communication addressed to the Board, County Surveyor, W. M. Bestaph, stated that on April 19th, he in company with the Hon. Lyman Steen proceeded to survey a line for a public road, commencing at the north end of Garland's Bridge across Weber River and running in a northeasterly direction to the section line between Sections 14 and 15 in Township 6, North of Range 2 West, thence north near the section line to the public road on the north side of the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 15, Township 6, North Range 2 West, the line run being the east side of the proposed road. This line will put the road on much better ground than the old road and is entirely practical. A map accompanied & accompanied Mr. Bestaph's report, showing a clear statement of the details of the said road. The communication and the accompanying map were ordered filed.
