adapted, and the route as laid out by the County Surveyor be, and the same is hereby established as a county road. The following is a particular description of the center line of said road, the said road being sixty-six feet wide.

Beginning at a point 1567 feet East of the northwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 15, Township 6 North of Range 2 West of the Salt Lake Meridian, U. S. Survey, and running thence South (magnetic variation $16^{\circ}30'$ East) 908.2 feet thence South $87^{\circ}15'$ East 976.5 feet, thence South $1^{\circ}52'$ East 874.1 feet to the center of the north end of the West Weber Bridge.

On motion of Selectman Jay Deeregan Cross was appointed a committee to prosecute the construction of the newly established West Weber and Garland road.

The claim of J. B. McFarlane for \$1.20 was referred to Selectman Jay.

The following claims were read, and on motion of Selectman Jay were allowed

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 7th day of December A. D. 1891 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book 7 on page 249 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Leading north from the West Weber Bridge:

Delectman Cross reported that the bill of V. P. Belcap for \$164 had been reduced to \$144, and recommended payment.

In the matter of the taxes of the Home Building & Savings Association Delectman Cross recommended a reduction in valuation from \$20,000 to \$3,000. On motion of Delectman Whittiff the recommendations of the committee were adopted, and the reduction assessed.

In the matter of the property of Mrs. Goodwin which had been sold for taxes although the taxes were paid, Delectman Cross recommended that the whole matter be referred to the old collector for adjustment. On motion the report of the committee was accepted and the recommendations adopted.

In the matter of the taxes of Peter Johnson Delectman Cross asked for further time. Granted.

Delectman Cross recommended that the former action of the Court whereby the road leading north from the West Weber bridge was located be rescinded. Delectman Fay moved the adoption of the recommendations, which carried, Delectman Whittiff stating No. The matter was then referred back to Delectman Cross with instructions to proceed with the County Surveyor to the ground to locate the most feasible route and to report to the Court.
