Minutes of meeting July 19th, read and approved.

George Peterson, petitioned the County representing that he is the owner of Lot 3, Block 4, Commons Addition to Ogden City, that said lot was sold for taxes of 1891, owing to an error in assessment, the same being assessed to George P. Hitzgen, and asking that the County remit him the costs of sale and interest. On motion of Solicitor Shurtliff the petition of George P. Hitzgen was granted and a warrant ordered drawn in his favor for \$44 as prayed for in said petition.

In the matter of the petition of James W. Harbonds and 19 others for a road leading from W. Harbonds to West Weber, Solicitor J. H. submitted a map and survey of said road, and recommended that said road be located as follows, to-wit: Beginning at the center of Section 20, Township 6 North, Range 7 West, Salt Lake Meridian, N. S. Survey, thence South 89° 58' East 2620 feet to the North-east corner of the South-east 1/4 of Section 20, thence South 89° 58' East 5290 feet to a point 2620 feet North of the South-east corner of Section 21, thence South 89° 58' West 44 feet to the center of the County Road, leading South from the West Weber Bridge, said road to be 66 feet wide. On motion of Solicitor Shurtliff the report of the Committee was accepted.

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 26th
 day of July A. D. 1892 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 on page 417 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From McFarlands to Street Weber: —

Beginning at the center of Section 20, Town-
 ship 6, North Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, U. S.
 Survey, thence South $89^{\circ}58'$ East 2620 ft. to the north-
 east corner of the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, thence
 South $89^{\circ}58'$ East 5790 ft. to a point 2620 ft. north of
 the southeast corner of Section 21, thence South 89°
 $58'$ 4084 ft. to the center of the County Road leading
 South from the Street Weber Bridge, said road to be
 66 ft. wide.
