

## RECORD OF THE COUNTY COURT OF WEBER COUNTY, UTAH TERRITORY.

June 13<sup>th</sup> 1893.

Lorenzo Fisher appeared and stated that he had a mare killed by being mined on the County road near James Taylor's in Salt Creek, and asked to be reimbursed for his loss. The Attorney informed the Court that the County is not liable for any damages. No action.

In the matter of the petition of O. R. Shaw and 24 others for the opening of Bailey's and Shaw's Lane, heretofore granted, Selectman Shumiliff submitted the following as the description of the road as surveyed by the County Surveyor and recommended that the same be adopted and that the said road be declared to be a County to wit:

Description of a County Road 4 rods wide:  
Leading from a point in North Ogden, west and North  
Intersecting County Road Leading from North Ogden  
to Hot Springs:-

Beginning at a red sand stone situated in the center of Washington Avenue South  $0^{\circ}15'$  West  $1422\frac{1}{10}$  ft from County Survey Monument No. 16. said stone known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 131. thence North  $57^{\circ}15'$  West  $2532\frac{7}{10}$  ft to Red Sand Stone known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 132. thence North  $82^{\circ}25\frac{1}{2}'$  West  $719\frac{1}{10}$  ft. thence North  $87^{\circ}27'$  West  $1013$  ft. thence North  $17^{\circ}27'$  West  $410$  ft. thence North  $62^{\circ}42'$  West  $285$  ft. thence North  $71^{\circ}54\frac{1}{2}'$  West  $372$  ft to red sand stone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 133. thence North  $0^{\circ}23\frac{1}{2}'$  East  $468$  ft. thence North  $36^{\circ}46\frac{1}{2}'$  West  $80$  ft to red sand stone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 134. thence North  $0^{\circ}43\frac{1}{2}'$  East  $870$  ft to center of County Road leading from North Ogden to Hot Springs surveyed and

## Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June A. D. 1893 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book 231 on page 231 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From a point in North Ogden, West and North:—  
 Beginning at a red sandstone situated <sup>in</sup> the center of Washington Avenue, South  $0^{\circ}15'$  West 1422.7 ft. from the County Survey Monument No. 16, said stone known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 131, thence North  $57^{\circ}15'$  West 2532.5 ft. to Red Sandstone known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No. 132, thence North  $82^{\circ}25\frac{1}{2}'$  West 719.2 ft. thence North  $87^{\circ}27'$  West 1013 ft.; thence North  $17^{\circ}27'$  West 410 ft., thence N.  $62^{\circ}42'$  West 285 ft.; thence North  $71^{\circ}54\frac{1}{2}'$  West 372 ft. to red sandstone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 133 thence North  $0^{\circ}23\frac{1}{2}'$  East 468 ft., thence North  $36^{\circ}46\frac{1}{2}'$  West 80 ft. to red sandstone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 134, thence North  $0^{\circ}43\frac{1}{2}'$  East 870 ft. to center of County road leading from North Ogden to Hot Springs surveyed and Monuments set by order of the County Court
