Cynthia Burgham appeared and asked that she be awarded damages sufficient to reimburse her for the expense of moving fences which was necessitated by the opening of the road leading southward from the West Weber bridge. Referred to Selectman Swanson and Shurtliff.

In the matter of the petition of W. H. Tracy and 51 others for the opening of a road from the point known as W. H. Wilson's corner in Wilson's Lane on the West line of Section 25 thence South 200 rods to the next County road and for the building of a bridge across the Wilson canal Selectman Swanson recommended that the proposed road be surveyed and opened, but that the bridge be not built for the present. On motion of Selectman Shurtliff the recommendations were adopted.

In the matter of the complaint of Miss Lucia L. Smith in regard to certain alleged obstructions in the road in S. Pines, Selectman Swanson, having investigated the matter recommended that no action be taken. On motion the recommendations were adopted.

In the matter of the petition of James B. McFarland et al for the opening of a road, heretofore granted, Selectman Swanson submitted the following as the official survey and description of said road, and recommended that the same be accepted, to wit:-
