

RECORD OF THE COUNTY COURT OF WEBER COUNTY, UTAH TERRITORY.

June 20th 1893. 0° 09' East 1726 Ft. to red sand stone, situated in center of County Road leading from Ogden to Taylor and known as Weber County survey Monument No. 136 thence South 0° 51' East 5323 Ft. to South East Corner Sec. 34. Twp. 6. N. R. 2. W. - and intersecting County Road leading from Ogden to Harrisville.

On motion the recommendation was adopted and the said road was declared to be a County Road

In the matter of the petition of J. P. Folkman et al. for the opening of a road, heretofore granted, Selectman Swanson submitted the following as the official survey and description of said road and recommended that the same be accepted, to wit:-

Description of County Road, Four rods wide leading from Plain City to Hot Springs

Beginning at County Monument No. 39 from which Eyrie Peak bears S. 77° 25' E. thence S. 69° 33' E. 512 2/3 Ft. thence N. 0° 21' E. 1044 2/3 Ft. thence North 40° 47' E. 1023 Ft. thence North 21° 10' E. 924 Ft. thence N. 34° 29' E. 1452 Ft. to red sand stone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 135 from which Berlemound Peak bears N. 62° 10' 0" and Eyrie Peak S. 71° 15' E. thence North 0° 07' E. 6195 2/3 Ft. to Red Sand Stone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 136 said Monument being the North East Corner of North West Quarter Sec. 21. Twp. 7. N. R. 21. W. S. 2. W. Brannings from said Monument being to Berlemound N. 71° 52' E. and to Eyrie Peak S. 56° 41' E. thence N. 69° 38' E. 2610 Ft. to the North East Corner section 21. Twp. 7. N. R. 21. W. thence South 88° 29' E. 3786 Ft. to North East Corner

June 20th 1893. Section 2¹/₂. thence N. 87° 50' E 2744 ¹/₁₀ Ft to the North East Corner of North West Quarter Sec 213. the same being marked by Red Sandstone known as Weber County Survey Monument No 137 from which bearing toward Towns W 63° 31' E and Opie Peak S 56° 38' E thence South 52° 10' E 700 to center of County Road leading from Ogden to Hot Springs and being West of crossing of C. O. Ry.

On motion the recommendation was adopted and the said road was declared to be a County road.

Selectman Sorenson recommended that the petition of C. C. Wilson et al for the opening of a road in Hooper district be denied as the frontier one not willing to donate a right of way. On motion of Selectman Wangsgard the recommendations were adopted.

The County Assessor reported the total valuation of property in Weber County to be \$16,073,635 exclusive of the property belonging to railroads, street railway, telegraphic and telephone companies a report of which has not yet been received from the Territorial Board of Equalization.

A petition signed by Wallace Foulger and 14 others and a petition signed by W. H. Wilson and 17 others both praying for the opening of a road east and west through the Middle of Section 26 township 6 north range 2 west commencing on the east side of Section 27 and running thence east through section 26 to the division line between Garland and Wilson school districts and the petitioners agreeing to donate right of way were read and referred to Selectman Sorenson.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 20th
 day of June A. D. 1893 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
9 on page 237 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

From Plain City to Hot Springs: -

Beginning at County Monument No. 39, from which Eyrie bears S. $77^{\circ} 25' E.$ thence S. $89^{\circ} 33' E.$ 502.9 ft. thence N. $0^{\circ} 27' E.$ 1044.7 ft, thence N. $40^{\circ} 47' E.$ 1023 ft. thence N. $27^{\circ} 10' E.$ 944 ft, thence N. $34^{\circ} 29' E.$ 1452 ft. to Red sandstone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 135, from which the bearings to Ben-lomond Peak bears N. $62^{\circ} 10' E.$, and Eyrie Peak S. $71^{\circ} 15' E.$ thence N. $0^{\circ} 07' E.$ 6195.5 ft to Red Sandstone known as Weber County Survey Monument No. 136, said Monument being the northwest corner of N. St. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 21, Twp. 7 N. R. 7 St. P. S. M., bearing from said monument being to Benlomonad Peak N. $71^{\circ} 52' E.$ and to Eyrie Peak S. $56^{\circ} 41' E.$ thence N. $89^{\circ} 38$

E. 2610 ft. to the N. E. corner Sec. 21, Twp 7 N. R. 7 St. thence South $88^{\circ} 29' E.$ 5186 ft. to N. E. corner Sec. 22, thence N. $87^{\circ} 50' E.$ 2744 ft. to the N. E. corner of the N. St. $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, the same being marked by Red Sandstone known as Weber County Monument No. 137, from which Benlomonad bears N. $63^{\circ} 30' E.$ and Eyrie Peak S. $56^{\circ} 58' E.$ thence S. $52^{\circ} 10' E.$ 700 to center of County Road leading from Ogden to Hot Springs and being west of crossing of C. P. Ry.
