

Dec. 12th 1893 for the year 1893 were accepted and approved upon the recommendation of Selectman Shurtliff.

In the matter of the petition of J. B. McFarlands et. al. Selectman Swinson reported that the bridge over the Hopper canal on the Buttermilk road will need some repairs. On motion of Selectman Shurtliff the committee was authorized to repair said bridge in a temporary manner.

Selectman Swinson submitted the following as the official survey of the road leading from Ogden to Hopper and he recommended that said road be established as a County road to wit:

Description of a County Road 4 rods wide leading from a point on the North line of Sec. 21, Twp 5. N. R. 2. N. S. 1. E. M. South West, intersecting a road leading East from Hopper.

Beginning at a point 7154 ft. South 42° 40' N. and 1571 ft. West of County Survey Monument No 621. Bearings from said Monument being to Observatory Peak, South 75° 35' E. to Ben Leonard South 12° 49' 1/2' East to Cyrie Peak, N. 46° 09' East, thence South 50° 44' 30" West 1590 ft. to Red Sand Stone, known as Weber County Survey Monument No 141, thence South 44° 32' 30" West 3000 ft, thence South 43° 24' 30" West 1240 ft. thence South 37° 49' 30" West 3108 ft. to Red Sand Stone known and designated as Weber County Survey Monument No 142, thence South 42° 56' 30" N. 11554 ft. to Red Sand Stone known as Weber County Survey Monument <sup>No 143</sup> being in center of County Road leading Eastwards to County Poor Farm.

## County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 12th  
 day of December A. D. 1892 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book  
 on page 460 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Resurvey of Road from Ogden to Hooper: —  
 Beginning at a point 7184 ft South  $43^{\circ}40'$   
 West and 1571 ft east of County Survey Mon-  
 ument No. 62. Bearing from said Monument  
 being to Observatory Peak South  $78^{\circ}38' E.$ , to Ben  
 Leonard N.  $12^{\circ}49\frac{1}{2}'$  East, to Eyrie Peak N.  $46^{\circ}09'$   
 East, thence South  $50^{\circ}44' 30''$  West 1590 ft to  
 Red Sandstone, known as Weber County Survey  
 Monument No. 141, thence South  $44^{\circ}32' 30''$  West  
 3000 ft. thence south  $43^{\circ}24' 30''$  West 1240 ft.,  
 thence South  $37^{\circ}49' 30''$  West 3108 ft to Red Sand-  
 stone known and designated as Weber County Survey  
 Monument No. 142, thence south  $42^{\circ}56' 30''$  W.  
 11884 ft. to Red Sandstone known ~~as~~  
 as Weber County Survey Monument No. 143, said  
 Monument being in center of County Road  
 leading Eastward to County Poor Farm.
