

## Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

May 29th 1894 1894.

Judge Bishop reported that the contract for painting the Court House was let to the lowest bidder.

The boulevard committee reported progress.

In the matter of the petition of William J. Bartlett et al for the opening of a road, heretofore granted, Selectman Swenson submitted the following as the official survey of said road, and he recommended that the said road be established as, and declared to be a County road, to wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of County Road leading from Ogden to Hooper 2360 feet South  $44^{\circ} 32' 30''$  West of Weber County Survey Monument No 141. (From said monument No. 141 Ben Leonard Peak bears  $N 15^{\circ} 26' 30'' E$ ) thence North  $59^{\circ} 57' 30''$  West 1475 feet to center of County road leading to Hooper and to East On corner Section 3,  $\frac{3}{4}$  Sec 5 T4 R 7 West. The recommendations of the committee were adopted.

Selectman Swenson reported back to the Court, without recommendation, the petition of George F. Nunter and 15 others for the establishment of a road "running due north from the S.E. corner of Section 29 T4 R 7 W to the S.W. corner of Section 16 T4 R 7 W." On motion of Selectman Waugard the said petition was denied.

Wilford E. Cragun appeared and stated that he is the owner of a mile and a quarter of wooden pipe which was formerly a part of the old Ogden Water Works system; that said pipe is being dug out, and covered up by the men who are at work on the new road from Ogden Canon to Ogden.

## Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of May A. D. 1894 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book N on page 164 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of County Road leading from Ogden to Hooper 236.0 feet south  $44^{\circ}32'30''$  West of Weber County Survey Monument No. 141 (From said Monument No. 141, Ben Lomond Peak bears  $N. 18^{\circ}26'30'' E.$ ) thence North  $89^{\circ}57'30''$  West 1475 feet to center of County Road leading to Hooper and to East Pi corner Section 3, Twp 5 N. R. 2 West.
