

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

Sept 17th 1894 claims deed. Referred to Judge Patten

L. B. Adams appeared and stated that J. C. Doby is assessed as trustee on Lot 8 Block 6, Woodman's Main Street Addition, and improvements thereon valued at \$150, and that there are no improvements on said lot. Referred to the Assessor.

A communication from the Territorial Board of Equalization was read. This Court is notified that the assessment of property in Weber County certified to said Board showing a grand total of \$13,601,232.80, has been approved by said Board and will be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts as the amount on which to compute the taxes due the Territory from Weber County.

The following was submitted by the County Surveyor as the official survey of the road running West from the Twelfth Street bridge, and on motion of Sebastian Swenson the same was adopted, and the said road was established and declared to be a County road to wit:

Description of County road partly 100 ft wide and partly 99 ft wide, Leading West from East Line South West 1/4 Sec 31 Twp 6 North Range 1 West S. L. M. Known as 30th extension.

Beginning on the East line of S. W. 1/4 Sec 31 Twp 6 N. R. 1 W in the center of street known as 30th St Boulevard, Fairmount Park and Fairmount Park Annex to City of Ogden, thence West along center of said St to the West line of Sec 31 Twp 6 N. R. 1 W and to the West side of Nebraska Avenue. From this point road is 99 ft in width, thence North 55 ft more or less to a point 20.15 North of the South West corner Sec 31 and in line of center of 30th St produced West from

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Sept 17th 1894 Monuments marking same within City limits, thence north 89° 02' West, 2799 ft to center of Utah Central Railroad, thence North 89° 02' West, 1111 1/2 ft to center of County road leading from Ogden to Hooper thence North 89° 02' West to West Line Sec 36 T⁶ R⁶ W² S⁴ M. Surveyed by order County Court August 17th 18, 1894.

In the matter of the petition of Thomas Slater and 14 others the committee recommended that the said petition be granted, and that the sum of \$125.00 be expended under the supervision of the road supervisor of Slaterville in building embankment for the protection of certain lands lying East of the Four Mile Creek from being flooded. The recommendations were adopted.

The committee on meat inspection recommended that the petition of W. W. Child and 63 others be granted, and that a place for the inspection of meats be established at John Manning's place in Hooper, and that Calvin Miles be appointed a meat inspector. The recommendations were adopted.

In the matter of the claim of J. P. Ledwidge of \$637.00 for extra work on the assessment roll Selectman Wanggaard reported that three claims were made out for the persons employed on said work and said claims were allowed. Report accepted.

J. P. Ledwidge presented a claim of \$705.00 for money advanced for clerk hire and for his personal services in making the duplicate assessment roll and on motion of Selectman Swenson the same was allowed.

Selectman Wanggaard reported that with some repairs the lower bridge in Ogden Canon will be good for a number of years.

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 17th day of September A. D. 1894 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book N. on page 374 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Leading West from 3rd Street
 Beginning on the East Line of S. W. $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 31, Twp 6 N. R. 1 St. in the center of street known as 3rd Street, Boulevard, Fairmount Park, and Fairmount Park Annex to City of Ogden thence West along center of said Street to the west line of Section 31, Twp 6 N. R. 1 St. and to the west side of Nebraska Avenue. From this point road is 99 ft. in width, thence North 55 ft. more or less to a point 2015 North of the southwest corner Section 31, and in line of center of 3rd Street produced west from Monuments marking same within City Limits, thence north $89^{\circ}02'$ St. 2799 ft. to center of Utah Central Railroad, thence N. $89^{\circ}02'$ St. 111.1 ft. to center of County Road leading from Ogden to Hooper, thence North $89^{\circ}02'$ St. to West Line Section 36, Twp 6, N. R. 2 St. S. L. M.
