

Record of the County Court of Weber County, Utah Territory.

Oct 1st 1894

A communication from George W. Matson was read. He asked that the sum of \$25.00 be refunded to him on account of taxes to that amount paid by him on improvements on L. B. # 101, in 1891, which said improvements he alleges were erroneously assessed. On motion of Selectman Shurtliff the said application was denied.

The monthly report of the superintendent of the Poor Farm for the month of September 1894 was read. Ordered filed.

In the matter of the petitions for the establishment of a road running East and West through the center of Section 26, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Selectman Swenson recommended that the proposed road be established, surveyed and opened up, provided the property owners on either side donate the necessary land. Recommendation adopted.

In the matter of the petitions of Ranford Smith and 16 others praying that the County road now terminating at the center of Section 12 Township 6 North, Range 3 West, be extended, Selectman Swenson recommended that the said road be extended due West through sections 11 and 10 to the West line of Section 10, thence North between sections 9 and 10 and 3 and 4 to the North line of Section 4; and also running due West from the center of the West line of Section 10 to the Great Salt Lake. Recommendation adopted.

On motion of Selectman Swenson Selectman Shurtliff was appointed a committee with power to act to employ a man at a salary of not to exceed \$100.00 per month to correct the assessment plats.

It was ordered that the petition of Mrs. Grace F. Rawson for relief of taxes be denied.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 1st
 day of October A. D. 1894 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
 A on page 391 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

 16 others praying that the County Road now terminating at
 the center of Section 12, Township 6 North Range 3
 West, be extended, Selectman Swenson recommended
 that the said road be extended due west through
 Sections 11 & 10 to the west line of Section 10, thence
 North between sections 9, ^{and} 10, ^{and} 3 and 4 to the North
 line of Section 4, and also running due west
 from the center of the West line of Section 10, to
 the Great Salt Lake. Recommendation adopted.
