

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 18th day of November A. D. 1898 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book 109 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Commissioner Jeaman introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption, to-wit:— Whereas the erection of a Sugar Factory in Nelson Precinct in Weber County has made necessary the opening of a public highway on the section line separating Sections 35 and 36 - Twp 6 N. R. 3 N in Weber County Utah, Beginning at the southeast corner of said Section 35 and the southwest corner of said section 36, running thence north the entire distance across said sections intersecting the public highway now open on the southeast corner of said section 35, and the public highway now open on the north line of said sections 35 and 36, And,

Whereas satisfactory arrangements between the property owners along the said section lines and the Board of County Commissioners cannot be made for the opening of said proposed highway as heretofore set forth,

Therefore be it Resolved, By the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County that the County Attorney be, and he is hereby instructed, authorized and directed to, at once, for and in behalf of the Commissioners of Weber County to institute the necessary proceedings in the District Court to have four rods of land, two rods on each side of said section line as hereinbefore described condemned to the use of the public as a public highway and for the appraisal of the damages to said property owners along said section lines to-wit:— D. W. Peery, The Adams Nursery Co. and other owners to this Board unknown.
The resolutions were adopted.

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 2nd day of March A. D. 1899. (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book on page 331 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Steen who moved its adoption and the same was unanimously adopted, to-wit:

Whereas it is necessary for the convenience of the public to survey, view, lay-out, record, open maintain and work a public highway in Weber County leading to the Sugar Factory in Wilson Precinct.

And, whereas the Board of County Commissioners having entered into agreements for the purchase of rights of way for said highway with certain parties but being unable to do so with certain other parties, instructed the County Attorney to institute proceedings for the acquirements of said rights of way, as provided by law over the lands of said parties and now several of said parties after the commencement of said action in the District Court of the Second Judicial District in and for Weber County, having applied to this Board to settle the value thereof out of said Court, and the Board having duly considered the claim of said respective parties and having reached a just and fair conclusion with each of said parties for said rights of way and said parties having tendered to said Weber County good and sufficient rights of way over the land owned by each of the said parties, it is therefore ordered that the said deeds be and each of them is hereby accepted, and the County Auditor be and he is hereby directed to draw warrants on the County Treasurer in favor of each of said persons for amount due them for said rights-of-way.
