

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 27th day of February, A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book M on page 330 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

A new Road in Riverdale:—

A petition signed by Adam Russell and ninety five others was received and read. They petitioned that this Bears cause to be laid out and cause to be opened for public use a County Road four rods in width along or near the following described road to-wit:— Beginning at a point in Section 12 Township 5, North of Range 2 West in the present County Road about one quarter of a mile west of the Riverdale School House, and running thence northeast about three-quarters of a mile to intersect the range line about 450 feet north of the southeast corner in Section 1, in Township and Range aforesaid; thence north along the range line to the northeast corner of the said Township, thence west one mile more or less, along the north line of said section 1, and intersecting the present County Road from Heeper to Ogden, a length of about two and one-half miles and being all or un-cultivated land. This road is for the purpose of opening up easy and direct communication with the Ogden Sugar Works.

On motion of Commissioner Smith, it was ordered that the said petition be, and the same is hereby unanimously granted.

Weber County, Utah.

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 2nd day of March, A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book M on page 331 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Steen who moved its adoption and the same was unanimously adopted, to-wit:—

Whereas it is necessary for the convenience of the public to survey, view, lay-out, record, open maintain and work a public highway in Weber County leading to the Sugar Factory in Wilson Precinct.

And, whereas the Board of County Commissioners having entered into agreements for the purchase of right of way for said highway with certain parties but being unable to do so with certain other parties, instructed the County Attorney to institute proceedings for the acquirements of said right of way, as provided by law over the lands of said parties and now several of said parties after the commencement of said action in the District Court of the Second Judicial District in, and for Weber County, having applied to this Board to settle the value thereof out of said Court, and the Board having duly considered the claim of said respective parties and having reached a just and fair conclusion with each of said parties for said right of way and said parties having tendered to said Weber County good and sufficient rights of way over the land owned by each of the said parties, it is therefore ordered that the said deeds be and each of them is hereby accepted and the County Auditor be and he is hereby directed to draw warrants on the County Treasurer in favor of each of said persons for amount due them for said right-of-way.
