County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the A. D. 1899 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book on page 18/ &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit: Commissioner Skeen, to whom was referred the petition of C. I. Middleton et al praying for the opening of a road from the west gud of 21st St. Its Olike Lane on the north side of the Rio Drande Western Railroad Campanyo tracked, reported that the Country Surveyor had made the survey of the proposed road and that the right. of way for the said road could be purchased from Mr. James & Stone for the sum of \$75 to through his premises in Decrion 36, Jup. 6 North of Range West, and. ommended that the road as petitioned for be opened to the public and that the sum of \$75 god be paid to Mr. Stone for a right of way across his premises surveyed by the County Surveyor, upon his execution the necessary conveyance, and that upon his so doing, the County auditor, be directed to draw his evaluant in favor of Mr. Stone for \$ 75.00. The recommendation of the committee was unanimous and appeared,
