

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 19th
 day of March A. D. 1900 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book
W on page 202 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

The following report from County Surveyor
 Gosteph was received and read and orders filed; to-wit:-
 To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners,
 of Weber County, Utah.

The undersigned County Surveyor would respectfully
 report that he did at the request of Hon. Lyman Steen, a
 member of your Board, on March 9th 1900, survey a public
 road in said county described as follows:

Commencing at the city limits of Ogden City at a
 point in the center of 17th Street as the same is now
 open, and run along the center line of said road as
 the same is now opened and travels as follows:-

Commencing in the center of East 17th St., Ogden
 City and run North $89^{\circ}05'$ West 95 feet, thence North
 $42^{\circ}23'$ West 145 feet, thence North $70^{\circ}09'$ West 198 feet,
 thence north $89^{\circ}45'$ West 1099 feet, thence North 84°
 $24'$ West 1248.5 feet, thence north $80^{\circ}44'$ West 141.
 feet to a point 1565 feet south of the Northwest
 Corner of the southwest quarter of Section 19 Twp.
 6, North Range 1 West 767 feet, thence north $1^{\circ}09'$ West
 2560 feet to the center of 12th St. connecting with
 located roads at this point. This road as now
 opened and travels is from 30 to 66 ft. wide nearly
 all less than 66 ft. wide. The accompanying plat
 shows the survey in detail.
