

County Road Book,

At a session of the County Court of Weber County, in the Territory of Utah, held on the 19th day of November A. D. 1900 (the minutes of the proceedings of which are recorded in County Book on page 44 + 55 &c.) the following described road was declared to be a County Road, to-wit:

Commissioner Smith, to whom was referred the petition of B. A. Montgomery, et al, praying for the extension of the road beginning at a point where it intersects the County road in Liberty Road District, such extension to begin at the point, where Commissioner Smith left off, at R. S. Montgomery's and running thence west 80 rods to Southwick's Corner, and the petitioners on consideration of such extension agree to give 3 rods of land to Weber County for the extension of said road, recommended that the petition be granted. The recommendation was unanimously adopted and thereupon Commissioner Smith was appointed a committee to procure deeds to the land over which the proposed extension of said road is to be made, and he was directed to have said deeds recorded in the County Recorder's Office, and thereupon ^{to} open the extension of said road.
