Disposition of Portion of Highways Realigned

R E S O L U T I O N

State Route 132

WHEREAS, with the completion of Project S-0279(3) from Fountain Green in Sanpete County northwesterly to the Juab County line, a distance of 4.9 + - miles has resulted in the construction on new alignment, a section of new roadway, and

WHEREAS, portions of the old alignment will serve as public roads though not justified as part of the State System of Highways, and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by Mr. W. D. Hurley, District #3 Engineer, and concurred in by the Sanpete County Commission, that the old alignment of State Route 132 from a point north of Fountain Green northwesterly to the Juab County line and the approach road constructed as a part of the project be relinquished and transferred to the jurisdiction of Sanpete County.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Authority of Section 27-12-29, UCA, 1953, as amended, it is hereby resolved as follows:

That all portions of highway constructed as a result of Project S-0279(3), with the exception of the approach road, be designated as a part of State Route 132,

That the old alignment of State Route 132 from a point north of Fountain Green northwesterly to the Juab County line and the approach road constructed as a part of the project be relinquished and transferred to the jurisdiction of Sanpete County,

That by this action State Highway System mileage will decrease 0.3 + - miles, Sanpete County "B" System mileage will increase 0.6 + - miles,

That the memorandum from Mr. W. D. Hurley and the letter from the Sanpete County Commission pertaining to their concurrence in the aforementioned

Enclosed is a copy of a letter from the Sanpete County Commission dat 1 October 15, 1971 relating to reconstruction of a portion of S.R. 132 north of Fountain Green. As noted, they indicated that upon completion of construction that they will assume responsibility for the abandoned portion of former SR-132 where re-alignment has taken place. This project is now completed, and we request that the necessary transfer be affected.

The portion being abandoned is 5.05 miles in length, from M.P. 41.95 to M.P. 47.0, just south of the Juab County line.

Dear Mr. Stephenson:

The Sanpete County Commission has discussed the transfer of the county road between Ftn. Green and the Sanpete--Juab line to the State of Utah for the new highway construction in this area, and it is agreeable that we make this transfer. Sanpete County will accept the present section of U-32 state highway between Ftn. Green and the county line to be placed on the county system.

We are anxious that the preliminaries be completed as soon as possible on this section of road and construction begin as near in the future as arrangements can be made. When I-15 is completed through Nephi we will see an immediate increase of travel over U--32. At the present time U--32 is in very poor condition and extremely dangerous for fast travel and winter travel. We sincerely appreciate your support in these matters.

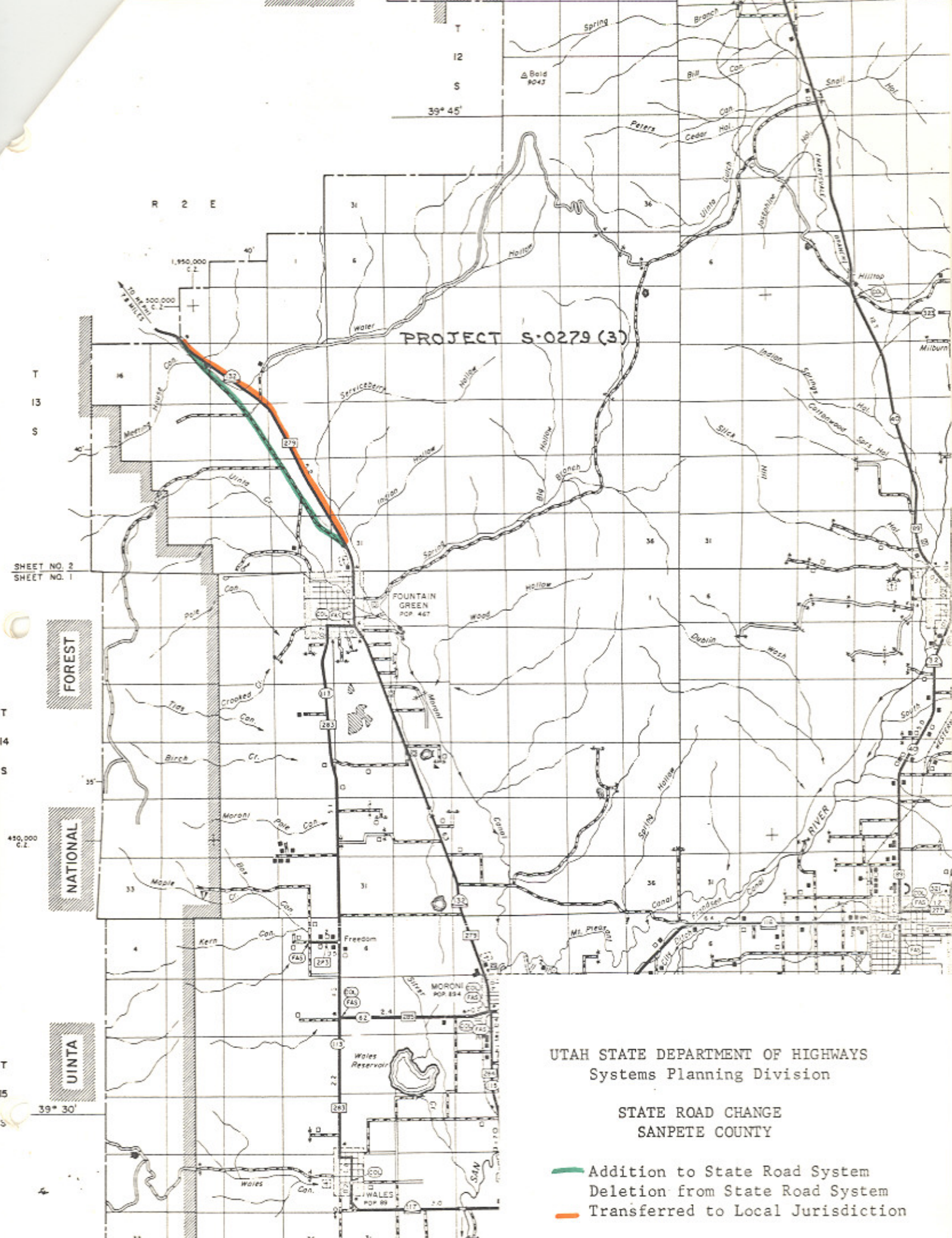

Abandonment of old highway right-of-way in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of
Section 22, T.15S., R.3E., S.L.B.&M.

WHEREAS, no disposition of an old abandoned roadway west of SR-132 and approximately two miles south of the City of Moroni in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T.15S., R.3E., S.L.B.&M. has been made, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation has no intention of reconstructing the highway in its long range plans, and

WHEREAS, the District Three Director recommends disposition of the property, and

WHEREAS, the Plans and Estimates Engineer verifies that the State does not hold the property in fee title.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Transportation Commission abandons all rights to the adjacent property owners of the approximate 2.25 acres formerly used as a highway in the 12.19 acres included in the following description:

SUBJECT: Abandonment of old highway right-of-way in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T.15S., R.3E., S.L.B.& M.

Will you please submit a recommendation to the UDOT Commissioners that the old highway right-of-way in the above described 40-acre tracts be abandoned to the abutting property owner. The parcel to be abandoned has been used for 35-40 years by the abutting owner and it has no practical use in conjunction with the present highway.

The above parcel is included within the following description (it would comprise approximately 2.25 acres of the total 12.19 acres):
