WHEREAS, with the completion of Project NR-133-(1) from near Pine Cliff northeasterly to the Utah-Wyoming state line a distance of 4.980 miles has resulted in the construction on new alignment a new roadway and,

WHEREAS, the old alignment will no longer serve as a public roadway and,

WHEREAS, to maintain continuity in the State System of Highways.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That the highway constructed on new alignment as a result of Project NR-133-(1) be designated as a part of State Route 133.
2. That the old alignment of State Route 133 be abandoned from the State System of Highways.
3. That by this action State Highway System mileage will decrease 0.3 + - mile.
4. That the map attached herewith illustrating the action taken herewith is hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.

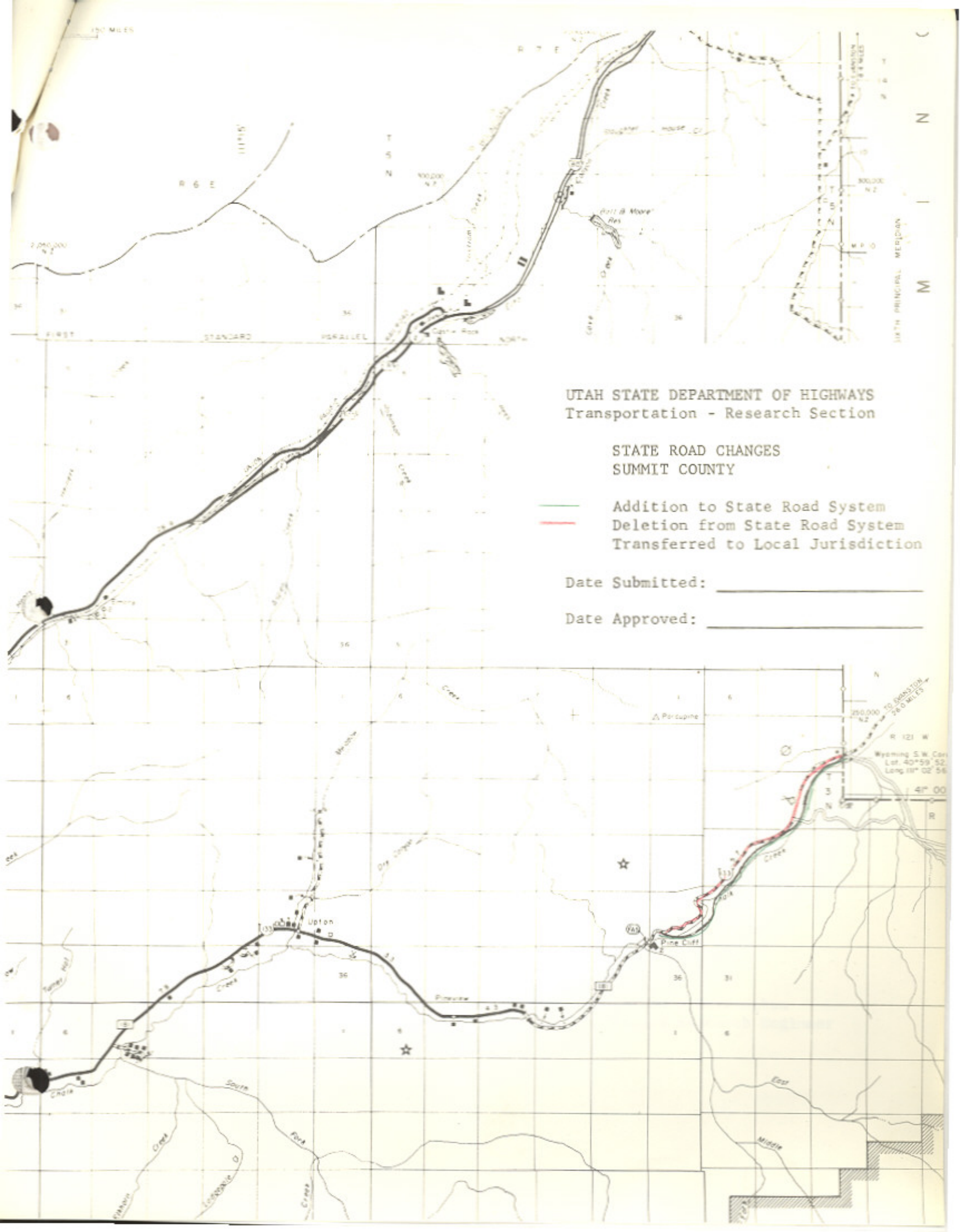

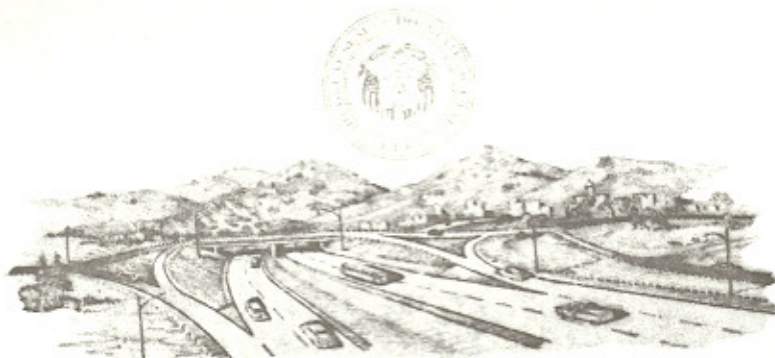
