DESCRIPTION OF RESOLUTION CHANGE

(A). Addition -

From I-15 via 800 South in Payson to SR-198 in Payson.



<u>Transfer of Portion SR-147 to</u> <u>Payson City, and Utah County</u> <u>Addition of SR-178</u>

WHEREAS, Sections 72-4-102, of the Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, authorize the Transportation Commission to approve additions to or deletions from the state highway system between general sessions of the state Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the duly appointed officials of Payson City have proposed changes in ownership and maintenance operation of a portion of SR-147 in exchange for a portion of 800 South in Payson defined herein, and

WHEREAS, the Payson City proposal would exchange roadways that are more appropriate for placement on the respective transportation systems, and

WHEREAS, Utah County having been informed of transfer of defined portion of current SR-147, recognizes an alliance with Payson City, and the County Engineer has agreed to allowing Payson City to assume responsibilities related to maintenance operation of stated roadway residing outside the boundaries of Payson City defined herein, and

WHEREAS, the Region Three Director having reviewed the request of Payson City, concurs this exchange would be beneficial to all parties concerned, and

WHEREAS, the Program Development Division, concurring with the recommendation of the Region Three Director, advocate the transfer of ownership and maintenance operation of a portion of SR-147 as well as the placement of 800 South in Payson City defined herein to the State System of Highways.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. That jurisdiction, and maintenance responsibility on the portion of current SR-147 from the Junction of SR-198 at 100 West in Payson City traversing westerly and southwesterly to the incorporate limits of Payson a distance of 1.95± miles be transferred to Payson City.

The aforemention portion of roadway will remain functionally classified as Minor Arterial and placed on the Federal-aid System as a portion of Route Number 2869.

3. That jurisdiction, and maintenance responsibility on the portion of current SR-147 from the incorporate limits of Payson City traversing westerly to the Junction with SR-141 and SR-147 at 5600 West in Utah County a distance of 0.97± miles be transferred to Utah County.

> 4. The aforemention portion of roadway will remain functionally classified as Rural Major Collector and the mileage will be included with Utah County's "B" System road mileage, and placed on the Federal-aid System as a portion of Route Number 2869.

5. By this action, The Transportation Commission hereby recommends that Payson City Municipal Corporation and the duly appointed officials of Utah County work together to address maintenance jurisdiction and responsibilities on any portion of aforementioned roadway transferred to described entities.

6. That UDOT in conjunction with aforementioned transfer hereby places roadway known as 800 South in Payson from the south bound on and off ramps of SR-15 (I-15), traversing easterly to a junction with SR-198 at the west side curb a distance of 1.34± miles onto the State System of Highways and designates this roadway be numbered SR-178.

 By this action the aforementioned roadway now designated as residing on the State System of Highways as SR-178 will be functionally classified as Minor Arterial.

 These actions will become effective upon passage of this resolution by the Utah Transportation Commission.

9. The accompanying Letter and Exhibit "A" will be included and become part of this resolution.
