DESCRIPTION OF RESOLUTION CHANGE

(A). Addition - Designated SR-187 as a peripheral road around the Utah State Prison.

R E S O L U T I O N

State Route 187

WHEREAS, to clarify the location of roads that are to be considered as part of the State System of Highways and maintenance responsibility for those roads at the Utah State Prison and,

WHEREAS, with the proposed construction of Project NR-187(1) and,

WHEREAS, construction of this roadway will provide a peripheral road around the State Prison compound.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

1. That State Route 187 commence from a point on State Route 1, north of the Bluffdale Road, westerly to the main prison gate, then continuing around the State Prison compound back to the main gate, providing a peripheral road around the prison complex.

2. That by this action, State Highway System mileage will increase 0.3 + - mile.

3. That the map attached illustrating the action taken herewith is hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.

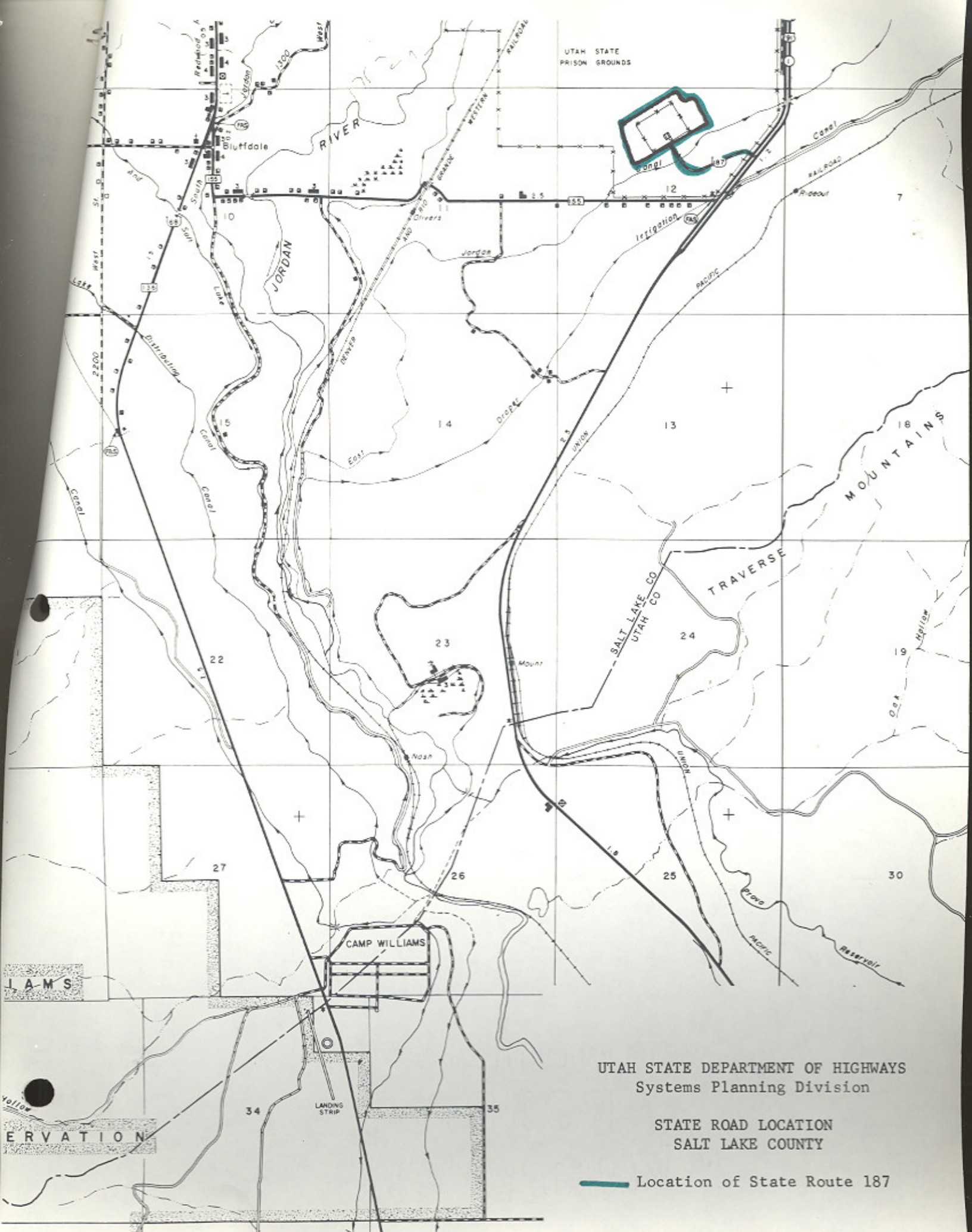

Subject: Addition to State Route 187 in Salt Lake County

Effective December 20, 1968, the State Road Commission adopted a resolution to place on the State System that road created by the construction of Project NR-187(1).

State Route 187 will begin from a point on State Route 1, north of the Bluffdale Road, westerly to the main prison gate, then continuing around the State Prison compound to the main gate, providing a peripheral road around the prison complex.

By this action the State Highway System mileage will increase 0.3 + - mile.
