RESOLUTION

State Route 188 *188 Land*

WHEREAS, a meeting was held with Mr. Harold Wadsworth, Utah State University, Building and Grounds Superintendent and Mr. W. E. Mickelson, Utah State Department of Highways, District Engineer, for the purpose of defining the maintenance responsibility for various roadways on the Utah State University Campus and,

WHEREAS, no allowance has been made for the expansion and rearrangement of roadways on the campus in recent years.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Authority of Section 27-12-72, UCA, 1953, AS AMENDED, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That the following roads will be designated as State Route 188 and for clarification and for maintenance responsibility the assigned sub-section numbers will also be adopted.

188-1 From 7th North Street south via 9th East Street to 6th North Street; thence, west via 6th North Street to 8th East Street; thence, south and east via the Peripheral Road to 950 East Street; thence, easterly via 550 North Street to 11th East Street.

188-2 From 9th East Street east via 660 North Street to 11th East Street.

188-3 From US-89 SR-85 north via 9th East Street to the Peripheral Road.

188-4 From US-89 SR-85 north via 11th East Street to 7th North Street.

R E S O L U T I O N

State Route 188

WHEREAS, on December 17, 1965, the Utah State Road Commission adopted a resolution providing a Peripheral Road at the Utah State University and,

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by Mr. W. E. Mickelson, Utah State Department of Highways, District #1 Engineer, and concurred in by Officials of the Utah State University, that a proposed realignment of a portion of the Peripheral Road be considered as a part of the Utah State System of Highways and the old alignment be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Utah State University and,

WHEREAS, to maintain continuity in the State System of Highways.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Authority of Section 27-12-72, UCA, 1953, AS AMENDED, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That the proposed roadway from a point on 950 East Street northerly to a point on 550 North Street near 11th East Street, be designated as a part of State Route 188, with a sub-section number 1.
2. That the old alignment between the aforementioned points will be transferred to the jurisdiction of the Utah State University.
3. That this action will take place upon the completion and opening to traffic of this proposed addition to the Utah State University Peripheral Road.
4. That by this action Utah State System of Highways mileage will not be effected.

5. That the map attached herewith illustrating the action taken herewith is hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.
