R E S O L U T I O N

State Route 211 *ced*

WHEREAS, to provide access to the Canyonlands National Park and
WHEREAS, it is the desire of the U. S. Department of Interior,
National Park Service, the San Juan County Board of Commissioners and the
Utah State Road Commission to provide a roadway of adequate design standard
to the Canyonlands National Park and,

WHEREAS, the construction of this road will be a joint venture of
San Juan County, the U. S. Department of Interior, National Park Service and
the Utah State Road Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved as follows:

1. That, subject to the approval of an agreement among the State
Road Commission of Utah, the National Park Service and San Juan County
relative to its construction and maintenance, the roadway from State Route 9
(U.S. 160) near Church Rock southwesterly, thence northwesterly to near Dugout
Ranch, be designated as an interim State Highway, State Route 211, subject to
the approval of the Utah State Legislature.

2. That by this action State Highway System mileage will increase
19.2+ - miles.

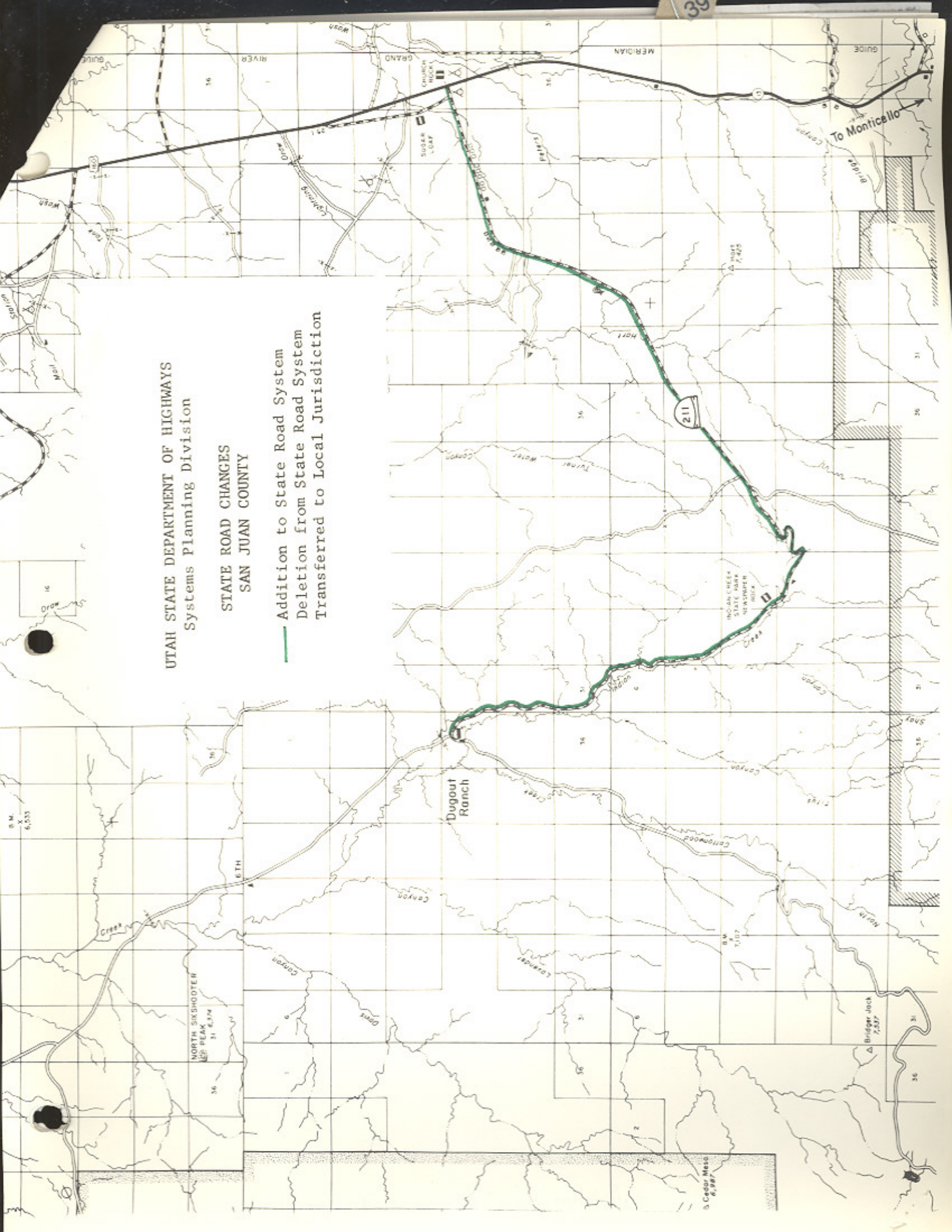
3. That the agreement entered into by the Utah State Road
Commission, San Juan County Commission and the U. S. Department of Interior,
National Parks Service is hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.

4. That this action will be effective upon the execution of the
agreement between the San Juan County Board of Commissioners, the U. S.

SUBJECT: State Road 211
Addition to the State Road System

The State Road Commission at its meeting today approved the resolution adding State Road 211 from US-160 near Church Rock to Dugout Ranch to the State System.

This addition according to the resolution is contingent upon execution of the agreement among the San Juan County Commission, National Parks Service and State Road Commission.

This agreement has not been consummated, therefore, notices of the addition should not be distributed until the agreement is executed.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the roadway from State Route 9 (US-163) near Church Rock in San Juan County southwesterly thence northwesterly to near Dugout Ranch was constructed as a joint venture of the National Park Service, the Utah State Department of Highways and San Juan County, and

WHEREAS, Federal funds will be required for the National Park Service to reconstruct this roadway in the future to an adequate design standard to provide access to the Canyonlands National Park, and

WHEREAS, to enable the Utah State Department of Highways in the interim to participate with the National Park Service which has Federal funds appropriated to provide necessary alignment revisions and maintenance on the existing roadway until the new roadway is constructed, it is necessary that this roadway be designated as a part of the Utah State System of Highways.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

That the roadway from State Route 9 (US-163) near Church Rock southwesterly thence northwesterly to near Dugout Ranch be designated as an interim state highway (State Route 211) subject to the approval of the Utah State Legislature,

That by this action State Highway System mileage will increase 19.2 + - miles and San Juan County "B" System mileage will decrease 19.2 + - miles,

That the map attached illustrating the action taken herewith be hereby incorporated as a part of this submission.

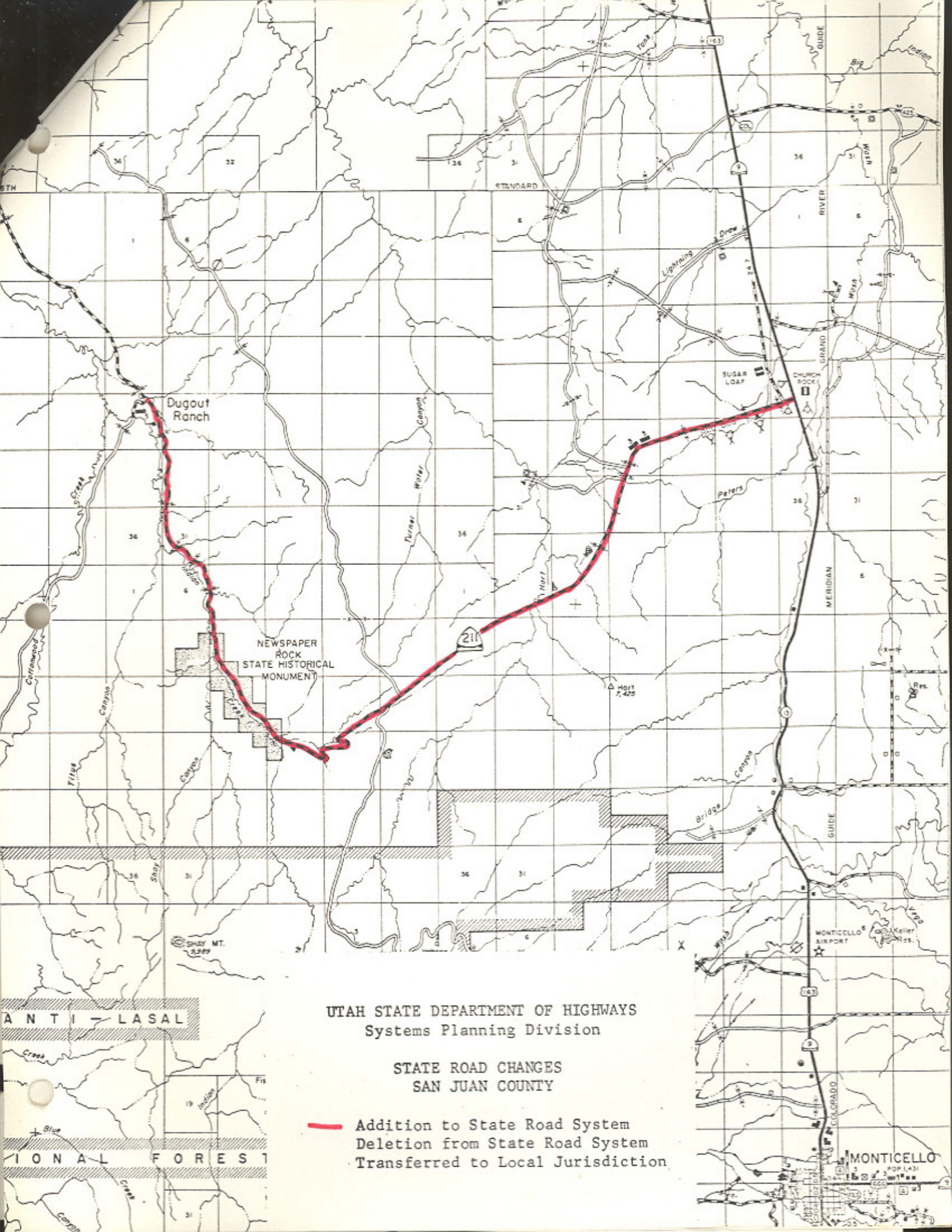
